AARRGHHH!!! Department: During a recent housecleaning session, my wife came up with several envelopes, postmarked July 6 & 7, which had obviously arrived while I was away, been set aside for me, and then misplaced, probably by the cleaning lady. These envelopes had several sets of orders which will affect several games.

Game 1975M: Spring orders (1907, by the way, not 1906) from Russia (Larry Doble): a lva-war; a mos s a stp; a stp s a mos.

This means that Germany does not gain St. Petersburg, has 8 centres and does not build; Russia has two centres, and still must remove one unit, as a stp is not annihilated.

The deadline must be extended one week, to Monday, Aug. 23.

Game 1975AZ: England (Larry Doble): Removed a wal, not f swe.

This makes enough difference to the English position that a deadline extension is in order, to Monday, Aug. 30.

James Hymas' and Doug Beyerlein's standby orders are therefore not needed for those games, and they go back up the list.

Game 1974B: Randolph Smyth (Turkey) sent a change of orders: the only order different was "a smy s f bla-con". So Randolph has a unit in smy rather than syr. This should make little difference to the position, so I won't delay the game but will ask sub GM Philip Chester to notify the players with the Winter season.

Iroquois (Bob Bawtinhimer): Has Moha, Cats, Onei, Penn, Phil, FtPt, Onon, Sene (8).

Ohio (Dave Head): Built Alle, Shaw; also has Detr, Liam, Erie, Ohio, Ming, Kain, Dela, Ches, Virg (11, 1 short.)

Wendat (Mike Stiege): Has Niag.
