- Turkey (Hau): Built f smy; has a bul, a con, f bla.

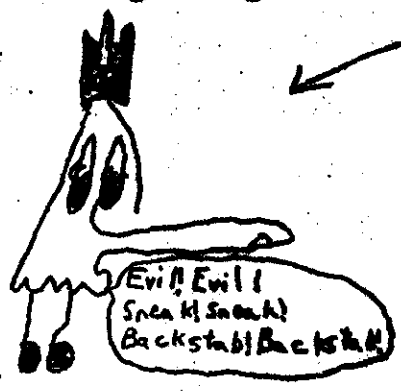
