Smith was a vigilante cop, and Tucker (best friend) eventually shot and killed Smith. It was an apparent case of self-defence.

I have not seen the movie. However, it is getting quite bad press in the San Antonio newspapers. People that are familiar with the case, and who have seen the movie, have almost universally panned the story and setting (though almost all praise the acting).

Comments in today's papers include an objection to the portrayal of the police department as "small-townish, a force consisting of a chief and a few cowboys." San Antonio has 1608 sworn officers. Another person stated that he now knows why they lead off these movies with the disclaimer 'based on a true story.'

I lived in San Antonio during and after the shooting incident, the trials and the lawsuits (some just recently concluded). It had a significant effect on the police department, and on the city. With the recent happenings in Los Angeles, this will have an even greater impact on the national viewing audience.

I'll say two things, based on the comments I've seen so far. First, this incident involves only a few officers (as does the incident in LA). Don't base your opinions of police officers, and law enforcement, on the actions of rogues. Every profession has their 'black sheep,' including police departments.

Secondly, the movie was shot in California on generic sets and locations. None of the magnificance and beauty of San Antonio will be seen. Don't make your decision about visiting this city based on the movie — it won't (can't) do the city justice.
