PROPSAL MADE TO END FEUD

Doug Beyerlein has proposed (in EFGIART) that an ombudsman be appointed to settle the Kathy Byrne-Bruce Linsey feud. This has been seconded in print by Konrad Baumeister (Give me a weapon) Rod Walker (Erehwon) and Fred Davis (Bushwacker), and may be seconded elsewhere before you read this. 



Greetings, my fellow Americans!! I am overjoyed at the quality of this issue. In case you haven't noticed, it looks a hell of a lot better than last issue. Why? My brother bought an Apple Macintosh computer! I believe this change will be permanent as long as he and I both live here. If not, there's always my printer! (break out the eyeglasses!).

Nobody seems to believe me about my changing my name to "The Razor's Edge". Why? I would like to hear from you about why or why not you believe me. Gary Coughlan believes me!

It is time for me to come out and state my standing on the silly feud which is tearing apart this great hobby. For those readers who don't know what I'm talking about, there has been a gigantic feud between Bruce Linsey (Former publisher of The Voice of Doom) and Kathy Byrne (Former BNC and now editor of **Diplomacy World**). Each ha several supporters. The feud has been going on for over a year, and is getting worse and worse. Bruce has finished all his publishing, and is helping with The Zine Register. In addition, Bruce has relieved Randolph Smyth of the duty of running the Runestone Poll (the hobby's major zine, subzine, and GM poll), and is undertaking the project himself. On the other side, Kathy, who did a fine job of being the BNC, was forced to resign by all the attacks on her. She has relieved Rod Walker (who has been overloaded with problems) of the burden of Editing DW. Doesn't sound so bad until you hear what has been going on recently. First of all, Jim Meinel, someone from Alaska, has circulated a letter encouraging people to boycott the Runestone Poll because he doesn't trust Brux to tabulate the votes correctly. Some are even thinking about starting another poll! This is ridiculous! Brux accepts the fact that many don't trust him, and has offered to let someone else, a

neutral party if you will, tabulate the votes of those who don't trust him for him, and then forward them to him. Sounds like an almost foolproof system to me. I hope that Meinel and the others (who I'm sure include Byrne) will, for their own sake and ours, accept it.

Also, some anti-Linseyites headed by Robert Sacks are even saying that they are starting their own Zine Register! This is ridiculous! You saw the letter in <u>Stabback</u>'s last issue. It is a bunch of ridiculous assumptions, and I highly disapprove of it. These hotheads that are opposed to the RP and the ZD under Linsey ought to at least give him a chance. It will carry all the games currently running in <u>Malaguena</u>, and will open a few more, mostly variants. Everyone will, of course, have to pay the sub fee if they wish to continue playing, but no one who has already payed a game fee will have to pay again.

Mikey Perry has created what looks to be an interesting Dip variant. It is called "Confusion Diplomacy". In it, the countries are randomly picked by the GM but not told to the players. Each player submits orders for all seven countries, and the orders for the country that that player is are used. Each player can only guess what his country is by a process of elimination. Some people may never know what country they are! It looks like fun to play, and even more fun to run! I will run a game of this if there is sufficient interest.

There are two more openings in the Regular Dip game which I will run. It should be ready next issue.
