BERLIN: The Central Government of the Citizen's Democratic Republic of Germany today voted to abolish all elections, parliamentary bodies, and elected officials. After crowning Emperor Charles the First all power to govern and all heads of governmental bodies will be in the hands of Napoleon Bonapart's nephew, Charles the First.

MOSCOW: President Boris Karloff appeared today with his famous negotiator and sidekick, Agnow Kissenstein and made an official governmental statement regarding Russian foreign policy.
