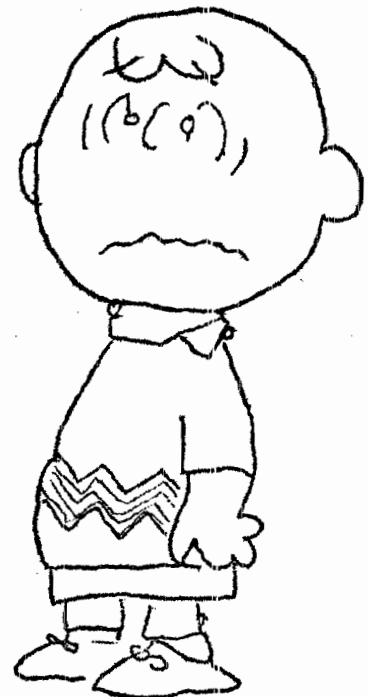
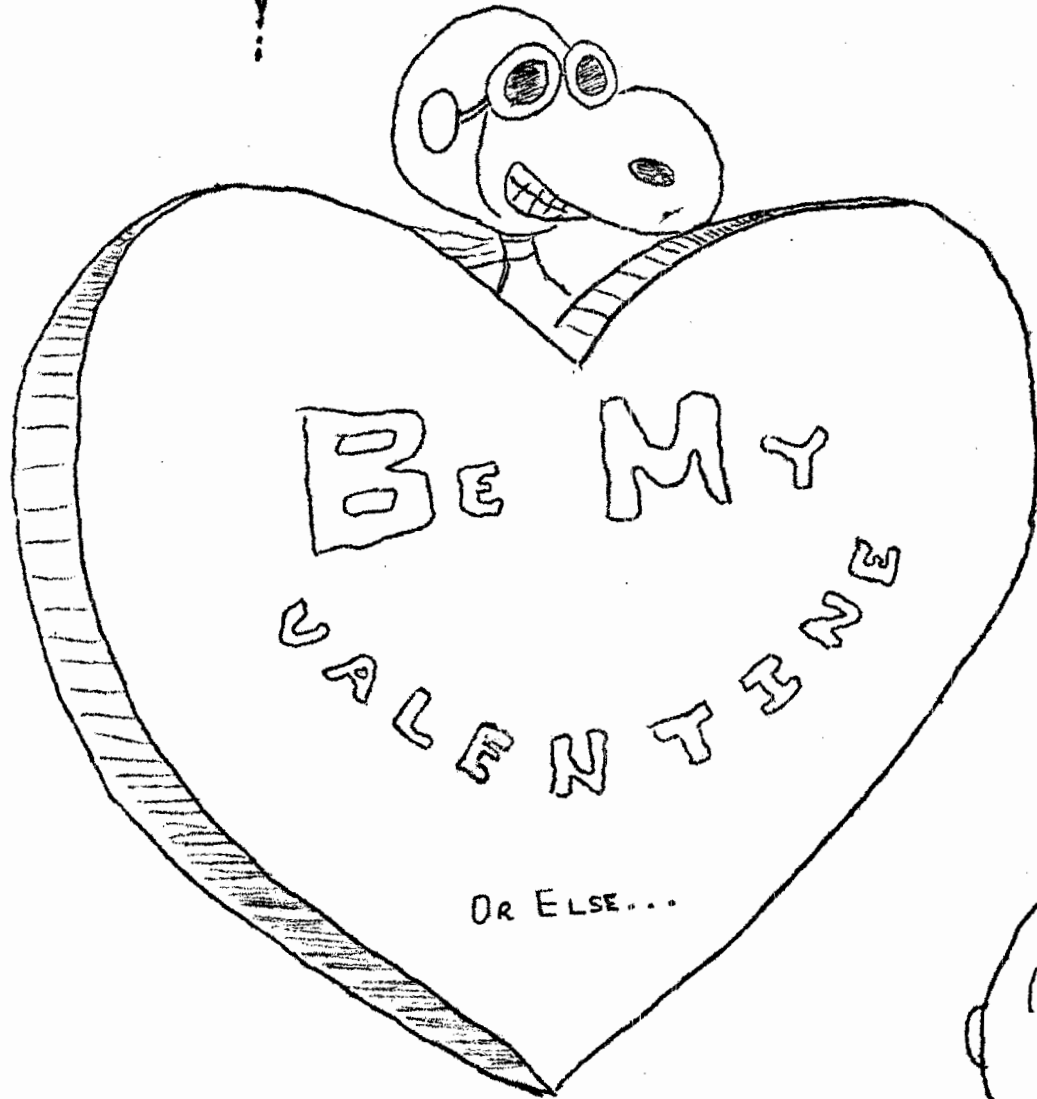

RALSTONSTADT (21 September 1910) The new Fall term got under way at Ryerson College campus of the University of St. Peerigrad with a massive student demonstration in support of faculty demands for the expulsion of SGS President William Linden Boardman, who has demanded the conversion of the school's agronomy laboratory into the world's largest greenebean farm. Faculty members have denounced this latest SGS as the last straw, or greenebean. Professor Henry Morgan of the School's Egomania Studies Department announced members of the ATF would picket the campus until Boardman was expelled.

Meanwhile, it was announced after the close of registration that all sections within the Greenebean studies program had been filled. The unsuspected hit course of the term was entitled Voyage to the Enchanted Isles, a commentary on the Galapogos Islands Public Restrooms, by former Prince Charles.

Provost Walter Lippmann announced that the Canadian Minister of Foreign Affairs (a most important post, since there are so few Canadian domestic affairs) would give a lecture later in the Fall on "Canadian Men and French Women: The Continental Viewpoint as interpreted by Henry McKantor."

ST. PEERIGRAD In preparation for the forthcoming victory celebrations, massive plans are underweigh here for the 200th anniversary celebration of the city. Their Imperial Majestys

have announced that they have commissioned Pablo Picasso, noted Greek matchmaker-playboy, to come up with the world's most controversial marriage-match. Other plans as yet are secret, but the Government has revealed the complete sale of 10 billion in rubles for a foreign consortium headed by American Howard Hughes, Frenchman Aristide Rothschild, Aristotle Onassis, and Alfred Rockefeller.

The funds will be used to construct a huge amusement center outside St. Peerigrad to be known as Diplomacyworld. This park is being designed by the noted American Walter Disney. The park is expected to be the largest in the world, but all details are secret until the opening next year.

YOUNGSTOWN (24 September 1910) Youngstown local schools reopened for the first time today since the occupation by Russian forces began. They were immediately closed by a combined teachers' strike and bond levy failure. The new year got off to a rousing start with the performance of Gabarelli St. Saens new opera, "The Russians are Coming! The Russians are Coming!" It was decried by the critics as being too far-fetched. Things at Ohio State University were quiet as Russian advisors to Dr. John Koning completed arrangements to change the name of the school's football team to the "Pussycats." The team is reported to be upset about the new pink and blue uniforms they will be wearing.

JERUSALEM (2 April 1911) Russian troops arrived in this city and immediately began the dismantling of the most precious relics of Christendom for their removal back to Russia. The Dome of the Rock, the largest church in the world, Golgatha, the Wailing Wall, the Mosque of Omar-Sans Sherif, and the Jezebel Towers are all slated to be dismantled and removed. Senior Russian architect Frank Lloyd Wright announced a monorail would be built from the Holy City to St. Peerigrad so local residents could visit the new sites without problems.

MURMANSK (1 April 1911) Russian naval vessels arrived here today and reported that the convey carrying the entire city of Liverpool, England, had arrived in Petrograd, where the English town will be reconstructed as a new housing project.
