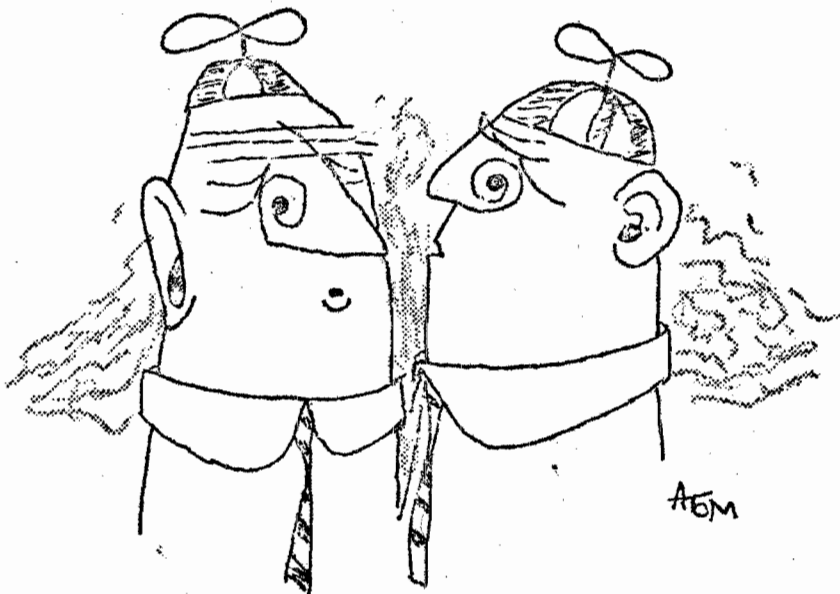

WHITEHALL - May 1917 (Reuters) The Admiralty has announced that the Norway Fleet will be withdrawn in order to allow it's replacement with the newly formed Highlander Army of Edinburgh. The Highlanders have been issued winter equipment, and speculation is that they will take part in a renewed campaign to capture Moscow, although His Majesty's government still insists that the primary goal of the war is liberation of all territory formerly belonging to the Kaiser under the agreement between the German Empire and the United Kingdom.

COUR OF ST. JAMES - May 1917 His Majesty's government respectfully reminds His Italian Majesty that Portugal belongs within the British sphere of influence, and use of its supply facilities has been given temporarily to Italy to allow His Italian Majesty to conduct the war against the Austrians. Now that Austria has been reduced in power, His Britannic Majesty respectfully inquires when it will be convenient to return Portugal to the United Kingdom.

PETROGRAD - 28 November 1904 (Butler Press) An Imperial Commission appointed by His Imperial Majesty Tsar Boris II to investigate the destruction of Grodno has finally made its report. It was a very terse statement: "The missile launched by the Ukrainian Insurgents against Grodno was not a duck egg. It was a silly goose egg."

WATERFORD, IRELAND - 3 December 1904 (BP) Reports here have finally confirmed wild stories of horror-stricken refugees from the north. Two days ago, Dublin was completely destroyed by a 3000-megabunk Billy James Hargis.

KIEV - 5 December 1904 (BP) Tsar Boris II reviewed His armies in the southern capital today. His Majesty also announced that the last ragged remnants of the Ukrainian revolutionaries had been exterminated by a 200-megaret Howard K. Smith. This latest horror weapon was used in conjunction with a 250 megalie Billious Buckley. The Ukrainians were burned in giant ovens constructed by the two horror weapons. The ceremony will be performed by the Archbishop of Canterbury, who will also deliver his Xmas Sermon, "If I Had a Hammer."

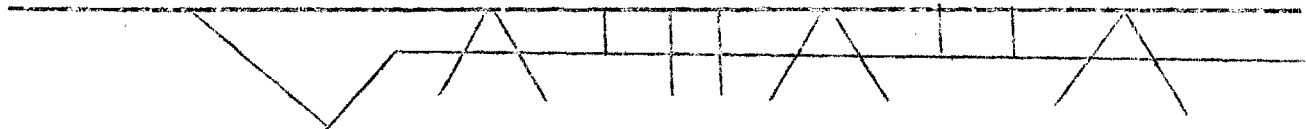
