I'll open any and all variants that any one wants to play, provided that I have the rules etc. There will be a variant sub. in THIS zinc shortly as well as in BOAST, it is MICHIGAN DIPLOMACY, By Robert Beascker. It is Diplomacy on the map of Michigan and it should really be fun for IOW members, to watch and play in. I have one signed up for this game. It will cost a sub, and a \$2GD.

A couple of issues back, I wrote an article on Origins and those are some comments from Joel Klein, 170-14 130 Ave. Jamaica, NY. #1434 Date Jan 20 1973.

"I think a distinction must be made between FTF and PBM Origins. In FTF I agree with you about the countries needing only U's being more likely to win. Even though players use ordered (placement) rather than simultaneous placement, the players all being there allows for more effective co-ordination. By mail, I thought Britain couldn't lose since Germany loses the advantage of moving last. But it isn't so (as far as I've seen). Since you can only exchange 2 or 3 notes between deadlines that co-ordination is somewhat lost. The specific allocations (sometimes in FTF for example the western powers may plan to have X number here, and Y number there to stop Germany. This particular precision can hardly be done). Plus, while Origins PBM doesn't require the great amount of diplomacy that DIPDIY does, some co-ordination is needed. One of the Western powers may be a silent player. What then?"

"I'm not trying to repudiate what you said. Even in postal Origins the U's countries, particularly Britain, have an advantage which should lead them to 1st or high finishes. But I also feel it shouldn't be too much of a shock when the controls start piling up and the dictatorships cop some, and sometimes quite a few games."

HERB INRE, Yes the C countries with big Pf placements will do well, but even then a U will have an easier time with out diplomacy, and lack of co-ordination. This is because they have a goal and they can go about it better than the C can. Time will really tell us though. Thanks for the letter.
