# The Beardman Numbers (What, again?)

In the Latest issue of <u>Everything</u>, Doug Beyerlein has announced that he intends to resign as Boardman number Custodian. The hobby, with Doug acting as its agent, is

new engaged in a search fer the new BNC.

It will be a tough act to follow. Doug has been BNC during the two years I have been involved with the hobby. I think he has done an admirable job under trying circumstances. The hobby owes him a debt of gratitude, particularly since he is arranging for his successor.

All members of the hobby are invited to apply to Doug if they have an interest in taking over the Boardman numbers. However, some people are more qualified than others. For what its worth, I have some sug-

gestions which you might consider before applying.

Steve McLenden, in Dragen and the Lamb, mentions that current pubbers should not consider taking ever the numbers unless they are planning to discentinue their ewn zines. This is a point well taken. The numbers, according to Doug take about an hour a night, every night. If you are running games too, you run the risk of burn-out. Diplomacy is a good game, but we are beginning to talk about its being your only hobby, and I don't think anyone would continue under those circumstances.

On the other hand, a complete novice to publishing should not take the numbers. Taking over one of the hobby's national activities is not the way to learn the ins and outs of publishing. My circumstances are such that although I can run a gamezine, my system would not be adaptable to publishing the numbers. A novice is quite enthusiastic when he enters the hobby, but can become quite disillusioned if he bites off too much at once.

Also, purely from a personal viewpoint, I don't think the new custodian ought to be closely connected with any of the hobby organizations: TDA, IDA, IDA-NA, TIDA, etc. I don't mean that the new custodian can't have belonged to one of these, but I don't think he should be closely identified with one of them such as Edi Birsan or Len Lakofka is.

I hope I haven't discouraged everyone, since we are going to need a new BNC. Doug has said that he will be interviewing prospective replacements at Gencon, which should give some of you added incentive to show up. However, if you are really interested, you should write Doug now for an application. And thanks again to Doug for the super job he has done.

With the remaining space, I would like to comment on the fact that I was forced to use all the standbys I obtained and still need more. I have said before in other zines that I don't consider it fun to win a game against NMR's. Consequently, when I find myself in a losing position(yes, it happens even to me), I consider it part of the game to continue to fight as long as I have a unit. When you decide to sign up for a game, do so with the intention of fighting to your last unit should the occasion require. I consider it a matter of personal integrity, and it certainly makes things easier for your over-worked GM.



Edinburg(Via St. Petersburg, 17 October, 1906) RIP Fermer Russian ambassader to Nerway, Fyeder Reszak, teday accepted the post of Russian Peeple's Envey to Great Britain. Reszak denied that the Russian military presence in Scotland was a hostile act against Great Britain. Reszak pointed to the great leaps forward made in Scandinavia under English pelitical rule and Seviet military eccupation. He said he was considering a similar system in Great Britain, whereby the Russian military eccupation would in no way infringe on a Scandinavia government ruling ever Great Britain.

Edinburg(via St.Petersburg, 17 Nevember, 1906, RIP)
Russian Peeple's Envey to Great Britain, Fyeder Reszak praised the great Irish Patriets' victory in gaining freedom from iron-fisted French rule. Reszak promised that no Russian troops will ever infringe on Irish territory and promised that the Russian Peeple's entire military strength woul be used if necessary to keep English and French forces out of Ireland. He said he hoped the courage of the Irish would be an inspiration to patriots in Tunis. Portugal and Spain who are still oppressed by French Royalist Forces.
