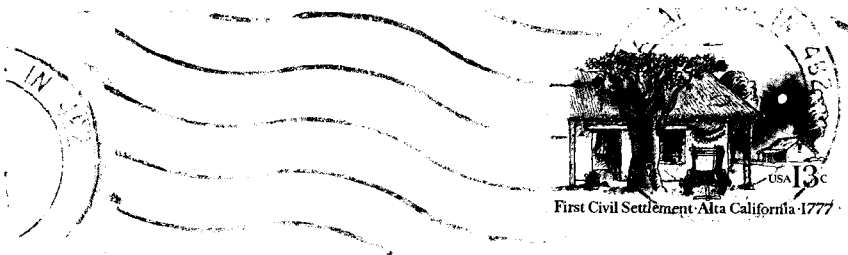
Turkey-Russia: The Sultan expresses to the Tsar that the course of the war is now in tide with the stars. It shall be as ordained.
