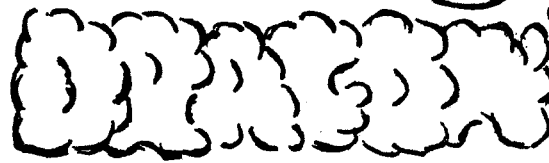

I first would like to mention that Dom Rittel is dropping out of the hobby. He has been a good friend and a good ally, and I shall miss him. This is typical of what's going on in the hobby lately. Zines of old and established reputation are falling by the way side. LenLakofka's L.D. which had been published since 1969 is no more. He is also evidently dropping out of the hobby. Other zines which I regarded as models of regularity have not been seen in a while.

So I have been giving considerable thought to the situation and to the letters I have received about Saint George. Therefore I have decided to continue with Saint George for the immediate future. As games end, I may be opening new ones. I believe this phenomenon is called "Second-wind".

I have received comments from a number of players that they were reluctant to make moves that would prolong the game. I wish to assure you that you should never make that a consideration. I have committed to carrying these games, and whether in the future I decide to withdraw from the hobby or not, I will carry your game as long as you decide there is reason to continue. No one should ever settle for a draw he doesn't want instead of going for a win or a smaller draw just because he thinks I want to end the game.

Since 5 of the 6 games had supply center charts printed with them, there wasn't enough room to resume some of the features. Saint George Speaks will return next issue. And we always welcome articles.

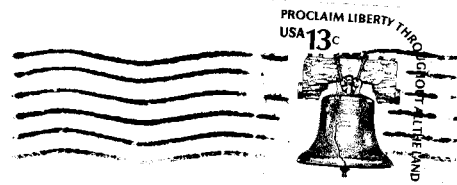
