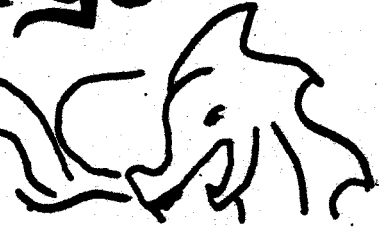
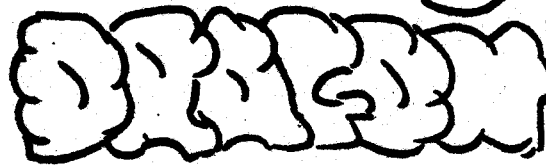

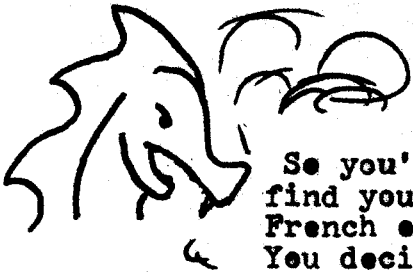

DRAGONFIRE

Belgium

So you've just your issue of the new game zine, and you find you're assigned England. You don't know either the French or the German player, so you go purely by position. You decide to ally with the German and wipe out France and Russia. Wrong.

England more than any other country can afford to wait a while to decide on an ally. If he decides to ally with France against Germany, what does he do about a 1901 build of F Brest. Or he allies with German, to discover F Kiel. A good France will have demanded that England build F Edinburg, not Londen - whether he is allied with England or not. And if England has built F Londen anyway, irritating France, it is difficult for him to receiver if Germany turns out to be hostile after all. And it would be a little late to start enlisting the help of Russia or Italy since they have made plans of their own.

But there is a way to find out whom you can trust. Ask for Belgium. Write France and tell him that you want Belgium because: your Army there can give immediate support to an attack by him into Ruhr whereas if he takes Belgium, he will have an iselated army there. You would have to use F North Sea to support his army in Spring, 1902, virtually eliminat- ing any movement on your part and also spending 1902 in a holding action, not in progress.

Now, also write Germany asking for Belgium. Point out to him that if you have an army in Belgium, he will be in the Ruhr. When he builds in Munich there will be three armies which can be used to get him into Burgundy.

The English army, which otherwise is usually committed to home defense, is extremely useful in Belgium to either an Angle-French alliance OR an Angle-Prussian alliance. In fact, far more than a French or German army is. The added advantage of an additional unit might be enough to persuade one of your neighbors into alliance.

And, you don't need to keep Belgium. You can promise to turn the center over to your ally as seen as is convenient. And you can do so with little risk. If France is your ally, when you turn Belgium over, you will be in Holland and North Sea, so there is little risk France can use that center as a basis for stabbing you. Likewise, if Germany is your ally, that center will be the only one within his reach, so again the risk of stabbing is minimized.

However, you don't have to turn over Belgium. You can provide your ally with other centers to compensate.

The real advantage is that you discover early who wants alliance with you. If France supports you into Belgium, you can build in Edinburg and an army in Londen with ne(or little) risk. If Germany supports you build F Londen. If neither? Then get busy talking to Russia and Italy before they build; see if you can promote F St.Pete SC, or A War. And if both? Then you should have no problem - everybody loves you.

In the absence of any information about the other players, then deciding on an alliance on the basis of beard position is the best you can do. But if there is a way to tell who is reliable, use it. Diplomacy is a game of personalities and needs to be played that way for full advantage.

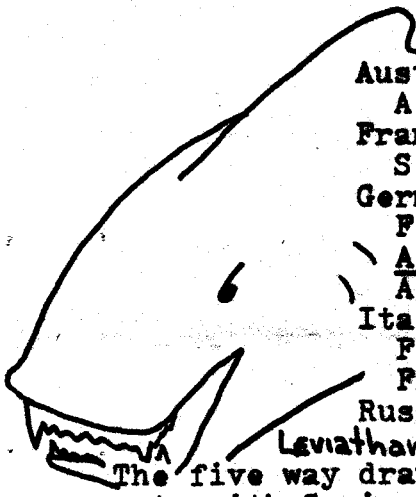
Australia to China: No B.S! O. K., Japan, Australia did what China asked. Now China do what Australia asked you to do.

1978HH: London to Mos, Ber: If I fall to France, who will be next ? France will have fleets in the North Sea & Norwegian Sea two turns after England falls. Italy doesn't seem worried about France with the Piedmont un-garrisoned.

Rouen: The Duke left here today with a great following of vassals. While his exact destination was unknown, someone said something about Hastings. Hastings ? Rumor also has it that Harold was last seen in Norway. Doesn't he realize that he was supposed to wait for them at Stamford Bridge instead of going to visit them ? 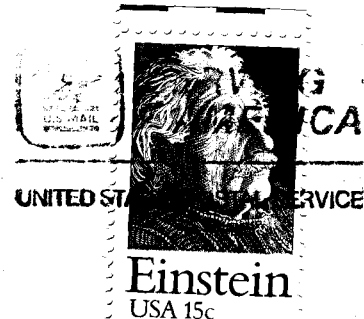
