SAINT GEORGE SPEAKS

Dave Crockett

Mr. Crockett has been the subject of much writing in Dragon and the Lamb. He is out to beat Walter Buchanan's record of 7 wins, a 2 way draw and a second out of 9 games. Mr. Crockett eliminated me in the one game we played to-

gether. I did not consider it much of my business if he wanted to beat Walt's record. So why am I mentioning him now? Friday, May 4, 1979 Dave Crockett called me. He told me that if I didn't get in touch with Steve and get Steve to step publicizing the questionable things Dave is doing to set this record. Dave would watch for any game I signed up for, which Steve also signed up for, and write every player in the game and tell these players that Steve and I engage in pre-game alliances - a statement which is not true.

I don't like threats, although I do not doubt that Crockett intends to carry this one out. In fact, I signed up for a game in Western Star Dippy, which Steve also signed up for. We wanted to play a game together since we were not in any game together at the time. Mr. Crockett, although he was not a player in the game, wrote at least one other player that Steve and I were allied. Before the game had started ! I am getting tired of Dave Crockett interefering in my games. Especially since, as he admits, I have done nothing to him.

But in the course of this conversation, the subject of 1978FK came up. In Everything 40/41 the following line-up im listed for 1978FK:

Against the Odds. Craig Reges. A-Andy Tomcufcik. E-Larry Cozzi, F-Bill Buck. G-Leland Harmon, I-John McArdle. R-Roland Dortch. T-Dave Crockett.

Notice the Turkish players name; it's important. Mr Crockett began negotiating when he received the game assignments. He says that the Russian player was in the game only as a favor to the Austrian. Crockett decided that he couldn't win the game so he dropped immediately. Further, he says that he has gotten the GM, Craig Reges, to alter the record so that Crockett will not appear as the original player. He also says that Dennis Agosta will also alter the record to show the same thing. What is this! If this is true, I offer the GM and the BMC an opportunity to say why, in their opinion, a player who began neogitation should be erased from the records - and any penaltyjust because he couldn't find an ally. All those of you who were the first attacked in a game and played the position out to the end, do you think Dave Crockett has a right to say that he "won all 9 games he was in" when he drops out of any game he doesn't think he can wim? I don't. And since Mr. Crockett says that he has compiled this record by "Being careful who I play with", he has, by implication dropped out of other games he didn't think he could win.

Being a phone player is one thing, but this kind of thing is patently irregular. One doesn't get to pick and choose which ones of his games get rated. Dave, you take your chances like the rest of us. When we sign up for a game, we have to find an ally. If we can't do this, then we have been defeated diplomatically. And that's just as fatal as being beaten tactically. While I applaud your attempt to win every game you played, it's time you admit you did not succeed. It's nothing to be ashamed of. But trying to falsify your record, and getting others to co-operate is something to be ashamed of. And as to your allegation that Ron Kelly Steve and I were trying to gang up on you-I have no reason to believe Ron Kelly would ally with me. He's allied with you in the game you're in with him. And I suppose it's merely co-incidence that Larry Cozzi seems to be signing up for games only with you...

And here are Mark's Pre-commentary comments....

With no moves yet available to be fuddle the commentator, a look at the line-up is in order. This appears to be a somewhat incestuous game. ((1)) The West's players (McLendon, Kendter, Sr. & Jones) are also together in 1978IS. McLendon, Kendter, Rohde and Mathias are all in WW III, and McLendon(sure gets around, doesn't he?) and Pyfrom are in Holocaust (A). This is limited to just those games which as of this writing are still in their first 2 game years. Going back even further would produce even more overlaps (e.g. 1978CO). Also - it doesn't cover all the zines, since

Everything is not being published currently.

I hasten to add that I haven't the slightest idea whether any of these players allow cross game considerations to influence their play, nor(since I'm in no games with any of them) do I care. Note I said "considerations" -- broader concept than just C.G. alliances and reprisals. (See Steve Hueston's thoughtful look at broader notions of cross game infulences in Claw and Fang #101). However, if they do arise, the players will have widely differing opportunities to bring them to bear on this game. ((Thanks, Mark. I'm looking forward to watching you and Glenn watching them.)
