THE TIP OF THE ICICLE

I think that there are a number of different species of animals that play Dip by mail. First there is the Novice. This tends to be younger birds many of whom are college students. Their primary objective seems to be to not piss anybody off in the beginning. They then hope to find some nice alliance in the mid-game that will see them through to a survival in the end. It rarely works. The timid opening is like blood in the water to many more-experienced players who descend like sharks in a feeding frenzy. Advice: Send out the overtures to everybody offering wonderfulness ail around, but make up your mind what you are going to do by the end of '01. Postponing a decision beyond then acts as an open invitation.

A related group is the Protectionists. They feel best swimming in a school, safety in numbers. 'Big fish eat little fish', so their objective is not to be a little fish. Gather in some dots, find some buddies and then settle in to picking on smaller fry or wounded neighbors. Survival of the species is paramount, some sort of win would be wonderful if it happens. The strategy is clear, and there is only one tactic: slow and steady wins the day. Advice: Don't be too predictable. A clever opponent can exploit a setting if your moves are obvious. You don't need to take unnecessary chances, but you should broaden your perspective.

Next we have a group of herbivores I call the Allies. They firmly believe the Dip Dictum: Two Against One Wins. They seek out an alliance with one [usually, perhaps with more] of their neighbors and plan all their strategy around the coordination of their moves. They want to stampede to a shared win from the outset. To stab will only enter their minds if it is a 100% sure thing, and even then they will only jump if they are so close to 18 that the path to victory is ironclad. These beasts are just as righteously indignant when they get stabbed. Their mode of operation is centered on trust. Advice: A tried and true method, but pick your partner well. Experience of others playing styles is very valuable. One must accept that sometimes a proper ally will not present himself and a rapid exit may ensue for you.

Then we have the Aggressor. These cats constantly assess the board and seek the best alternatives for their advancement. They will usually ally with some one to start with but will not hesitate to stab in the mid-game if there is even a 2 or 3 dot advantage to be gained. These predators usually have a fairly firm tactical background to support their adventures. The solo win is their objective but a shared win is acceptable if that is what can be achieved. Their nightmare is someone else gaining a solo; so they will jump to an alliance to stop a leader (lead group). Advice:

The Achilles heel is brazenness/overconfidence. Being too bold can push everyone else to gang up against you. Ones reputation can also mitigate against ones chances if this is the only style one adopts. Advice to others: Keep this player honest. They can be a great partner (stategically and tactically) if they never get an opportunity that they feel they can't pass up.

A sub-species is the Opportunist. They survey the scene and choose a course based primarily on its probability of success. Once a target has presented itself they aggressively pursue it as long as conditions remain the same. These omnivores do not purposefully lie to people but one dot tastes as good as another. They fully intend to be a good ally but if the wind starts to blow strongly in the other direction they will drop in for lunch. Any type of win will fill their belly and even a survival leaves no hunger pangs. Tactically they must be strong to survive but their long term perspective may be weaker. Advice: Avoid the temptation to jump ship when the first puff of wind blows up. Quick traitors are despised and to Building is a common reaction [they set their teeth and try to drag you down with them].

Ah, the Loose Cannon. These monkeys play a game. To win is not the objective, it's to have fun. Strategically these primates can go in any number of directions because what will give them Fun can change throughout the game. Often they will choose a course simply to see how it will work out. The Toady position is wholly acceptable because it gives a focus after the possibility of winning is gone. Advice: Avoid this approach in the openning. Fall back to it when other avenues are closed off, or announce it openly, eg. "Press: I'm doing this just cuz I want to see if . .?" Try not to do things JUST to piss people off. That reputation sticks for a long time and will certainly lead to many early exits.

LETTER BOMBS

Jason Wilke: I'm glad to know someone out there agrees with me. Those damn smokers seem to be everywhere. I, too, am allergic to the smoke and it pisses me off when people smoke in public - especially in rental cars and hotel rooms and restaurants - since the stench lingers for months after the smokers leave. Businesses that are so worried about losing smokers by infringing on their rights should worry about losing the non-smokers by infringing on their eyes, noses and lungs!

Ray Grib: I read with interest your tirade against smokers. For the recrod: I'm a non-smoker too and I dislike being in close proximity to smokers. However, don't you think your pleas are a little extreme? People who smoke do derive pleasure from it and probably realize they are harming their health. If the guy on the next barstool was wolfing down a box of Twinkies, would you protest too? After all, he is eventually going to eat himself into a coronary that your tax/insurance dollars will pay for just as the smoker's cancer. I realize the Twinkie-eater isn't "blowing" Twinkies into your face and harming you, but do you really want the government to regulate what we humans choose to do to our bodies? After all, whether it be booze, cigarettes,

Twinkies, drugs, etc? I don't want some self-righteous government bastards telling me how to live my life. I know the risks and consequences of over-indulgence and what I choose to do to myself is nobodyelse's business. As for the smoky bars, diners, etc; don't patronize them! Any public business should be allowed to declare themselves smoking, non-smoking, or both and eventually supply and demand business philosophy should level out the playing field. In Canada's case for example, about 30% of all establishments will promote smoking. I realize that being around smokers can harm a non-smoker, so just get up and walk out! Just like if you don't like the program, change the channel, or don't rent the flick, etc. But please, don't encourage the government to rob us of more of our dwindling freedoms.

ECY: There are two arguments: In a confined space should one person be allowed to do an action that directly and negatively impacts another? and Should one be covered in the event of 'injury' when one has willingly carried out actions that are known to lead directly to that injury? In the former it is acceptable to have areas that are posted for that activity, just as there are nudist beaches. But this is like saying that we should have pools where pissing and pooping are allowed and others where it isn't. In the latter, an emphatic NO! If you drink and drive your insurance is null and void, you're on your own. If you smoke, you're on your own for health care. Not an infringement of a right. You can do it, just don't come crying when you get burned.




Spam-Hill: Hmm, BDSL (BritDotSuckingLeach) just don't sound as good as "The Spammerl". But feel free to submit more suggestions.


