The Greek just shook his head and hoped for reassignment to something safer in the Resistance. Bomb-disposal, maybe.

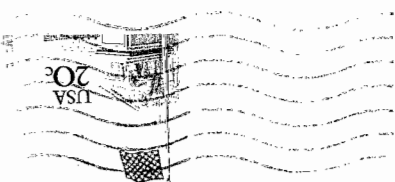
London Times-Dispatch: September 8, 1910

The Royal Far East Naval Contingent has proudly announced the return of the Union Jack to Borneo soil after a 3-year hiatus. Commander Montgomery MacArthur was heard to utter the triumphant words, "We have returned," as he waded ashore. Some scattered resistance was met.

Pretoria Record- September 20, 1910: Our victorious armies are still forging ahead with even greater speed than was anticipated. There have been some concern about their outrunning their supply. Hopefully, this falls naval battles will clear the seas to the East and West so that sea transport can be used for supply.

The devastation that has been found in the wake of the retreating Italian and Turkish troops is unparalleled in the history of the world. Millions of people have been killed, women and children among the civilians slaughtered like so-much-cattle. It is by far the worst in Turkish held Kenya, one 'Concentration Area' reported to have held 200,000 people, held only 5,000 when liberated. There is great fear on what will be found further North in Ethiopia and Sudan.
