JOHANESBURG - Maurice d' Mau Mau, head of the democratically elected government, representing all the people of Africa, addressed the World today on the occasion of the beginning of this year's session of the Trans-African Continental Congress. He spoke to the large issues of our Time, requesting global tolerance for African tribal beliefs. equal economic opportunity in the world market place, and freedom from Japanese/ United States conivance and imperialistic aggression.

"We point out that the Yankees have many problems of their own to solve within their own borders," he said, "and yet they remain present, like vultures over a carcass, ready to swoop down on our bones from their perch in Madacascar. We can only hope that some of our blood brethren have survived the onerous years of occupation." There has been no word from the island

for many years as to the fate of its many inhabitants.

"Meanwhile," Mr. d' Mau Mau continued, "our war of liberation for our likewise enslaved brethen in South America, ripped from the breast of their Homeland here in Africa centuries ago, continues. Can there be no end to the ambitions of these rapacious Japanese and their running dog allies from the North?"

He appealed for a Global Truce and promised to take the issue to Tokyo

and a Summit Conference with the Emperor.


