
HE APPALAGEAN GENERAL

MOSCOW-WORLD: Note that I have stayed completely neutral. I am open for negotiations.

Fresh reports from our intellignece correspondents (possibly from satellite sources) indicate that Russian and Chinese troops are massing in Siberia and Manchuria. Tanks, artillery, and aircraft are moving into frontier areas, and tensions along the border are reported to be high. Is World War Four on the way?

Melbourne Times, June 2101: The Commonwealth of Australia has chosen to re-name itself. The Commonpoor of Australia has just realized that it is the only major power alive in the world today incapable of deriving economic gain during the Spring season of 2101. Our fleets have searched the oceans far and wide and discovered nothing but desolation. We hear wonderous tales of the bountiful harvests brought back from such obscure sites as argentina, guiana, pakistan, VIETNAM, zambia and QUEBEC. No longer the poor pickings for conquering armies during the spring as in the early twentieth century wars. The 20th century English have resurrected themselves as the Aussies in the 21st!

(Moscow Times; September 23, 2101): After a bloody revolution which has been going on for almost a year, democracy has a last come to Russia (formerly known as the Soviet Union). General Ian Eilaaski has resigned his post as leader of the resistance movement to become the first President of Russia under the new constitution. Soon a military alliance with the U.S. will be signed; its purpose will be to bring deomocracy and peace to the rest of the world.

Government Information Ministry (MGdI) press release; 14 October 2101; La Paz, Territory of Bolivia: "Reports from northern Bolivia received today state that the last organized nationalist resistance forces surrendered to elements of the 3d (Sao Paulo) Light Infantry division. General of Division Barros Sampaio stated that his forces captured about 5500 conbattants, 2500 rifles, 100 machine guns, and about 75 tons of partially refined cocaine, which was destroyed. Several officers of the resistance forces dace criminal charges despite the general political amnesty. This action signals the end of major military operations in this area, and the pacification of nearly all of Latin America."

A 2/3 majority is required.




