


Government Information Ministry press release, 2 February 2102; "In view of the increasingly unstable international situation, the Assistant Foreign Minister for African Affairs, Rafael Brites da Silva, arrived this afternoon in Pretoria, the capital of the South African Federation. On the top of Minister da Silva's agenda is our government's concern with the South African nuclear force and with the Pretoria regime's deep suspicions of our motives and goals. We devoutly hope for a peaceful resolution to the present situation."

Pretoria Free Press: March 12, 2102: The government announced today that it is embarking upon a new naval program, to be completed by next winter. This comes on the release of classified documents to the Free Press which indicate a lack of response from Brazil to diplomatic overtures. Similar plans to modernize the army were scrapped after a high-level summit between the South African Government and the Pan-Arab League.




