EGYPT purchases PHILOSOPHY with 2 gems (32) + 3 gold (81) + 2 ivory (36) + 20 credit (Mysticism) + 20 credit (Medicine) + 20 credit (Coinage) + 20 credit (Astronomy) + 20 credit (Engineering) = 249  
Returns 1 card to the one pile.

BABYLON purchases COINAGE with 2 spice (23) + 2 iron (8) + 20 credit (Mysticism) + 20 credit (Engineering) + 20 credit (Astronomy) + 14 treasury = 110  
Returns 1 card to the eight pile and 1 card to the one pile.

ASSYRIA purchases MEDICINE with 1 resin (11?) + 3 papyrus (18) + 10 treasury = 140  
Returns 1 card to the nine pile.

CRETE purchases LITERACY and METALWORKING with 4 cloth (90) + 4 silver (96) + 10 credit (Engineering) + 5 credit (Architecture) + 5 credit (Mysticism) = 196

THRACE purchases DRAMA & POETRY and COINAGE with 5 wine (125) + 2 gems (32) + 5 credit (Architecture) + 13 treasury = 175

ITALY purchases nothing.

Returns 1 card to the one pile, 2 cards to the two pile, 2 cards to the three pile, 1 card to the four pile, and 1 card to the six pile.

#### CALAMITIES

Volcano @ B6 erupts. Italy loses one city @ D6.

Famine. Italy has pottery and three grain, so no effect. They decline to subject anyone else to the famine.

Civil War. Egypt owns Philosophy and so the first faction is composed of 15 points chosen by the person with the most tokens in stock. This is Thrace with 34. Thrace chooses to take the city @ D4, and 3t @ D6, 2t @ D3, 2t @ D5, 2t @ D7, and 1t @ D9. These are converted to Thracians.

#### ALTER AST

Assyria, and Egypt move up to the 11th square. Babylon moves up to the 10th square. Crete, Italy, and Thrace are held back at the 10th square.

Assyria, Babylon, and Egypt are in the Early Iron Age. Crete, Italy, and Thrace are in the Late Bronze Age.

Crete, Italy, and Thrace can not move further until they have acquired seven CIV cards.

As a note, there are 16 squares on the AST Chart.

Turn 13A will be due by November 9, 1987. Failure to send in moves will result in no population expansion or movement.

#### PRESS

As civil unrest and dissension grows within the Egyptian empire, the pharaoh searches desperately for some way to calm the populace. Originally intended to spread the priestly concept of literacy among the people, which would use up an easily affordable portion of the trade profits, the pharaoh has realized that desperate times call for desperate measure. Hearing that a great philosopher, one Plato, is abroad looking for work, the Pharaoh engages to contract with him. But alas, once again the barbarian Assyrians have caused trouble. Since Plato refused to serve in the ignorant warring masses heading south, he was thrown in jail. His jailers required a massive ransom to get him out, but the pharaoh is giving up a great portion of his personal wealth to free the philosopher from tyrannous bondage. "Alas, my gold, my ivory, my gems!", cries the pharaoh, near to tears. The ransom is paid, and for once, the dishonest, thieving piratical Assyrians are true to their word. In Plato's long passage to Egyptian enlightenment, however, at least one city and several provinces are lost to citizens selling themselves to the highest bidder!

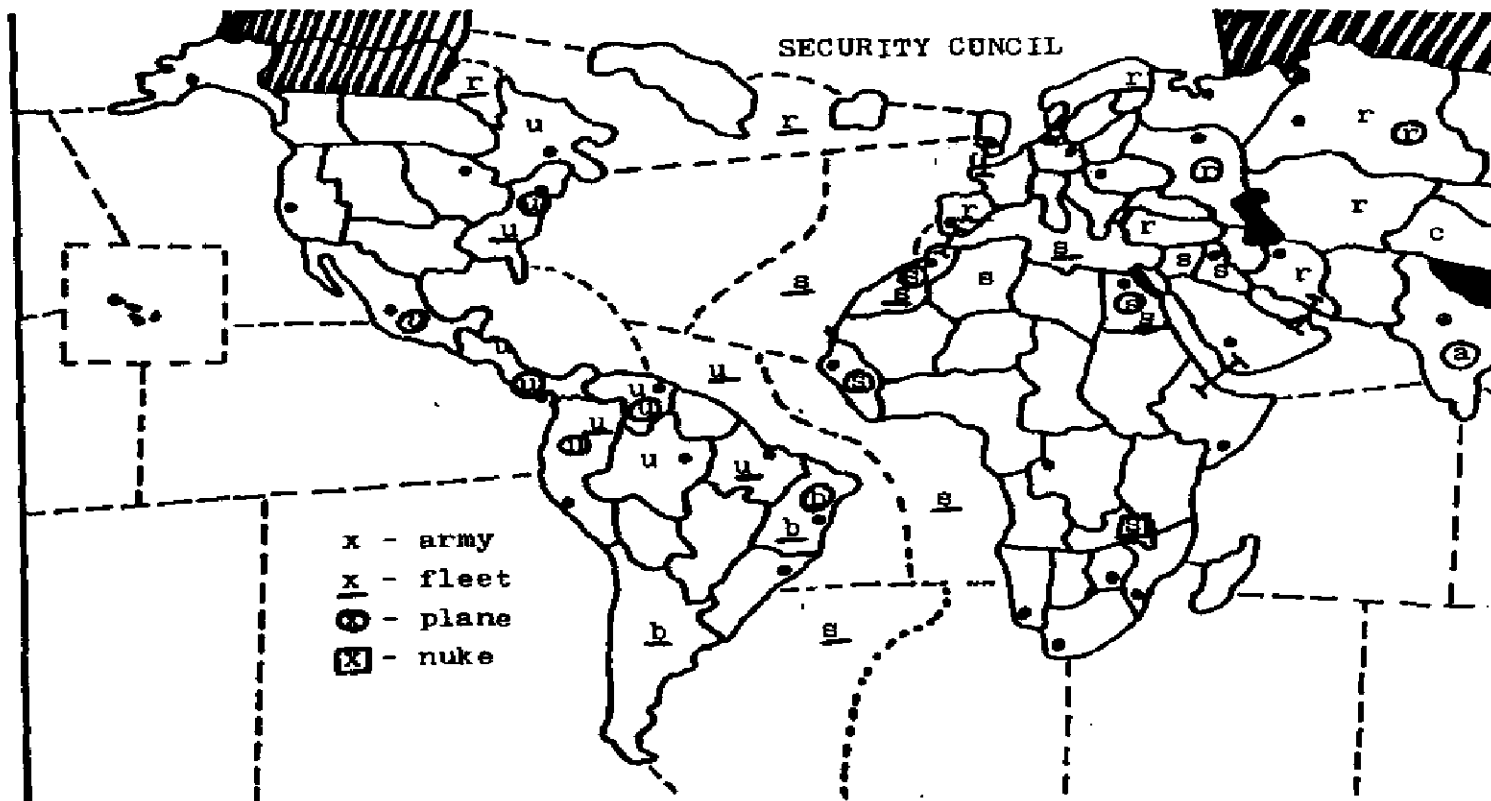

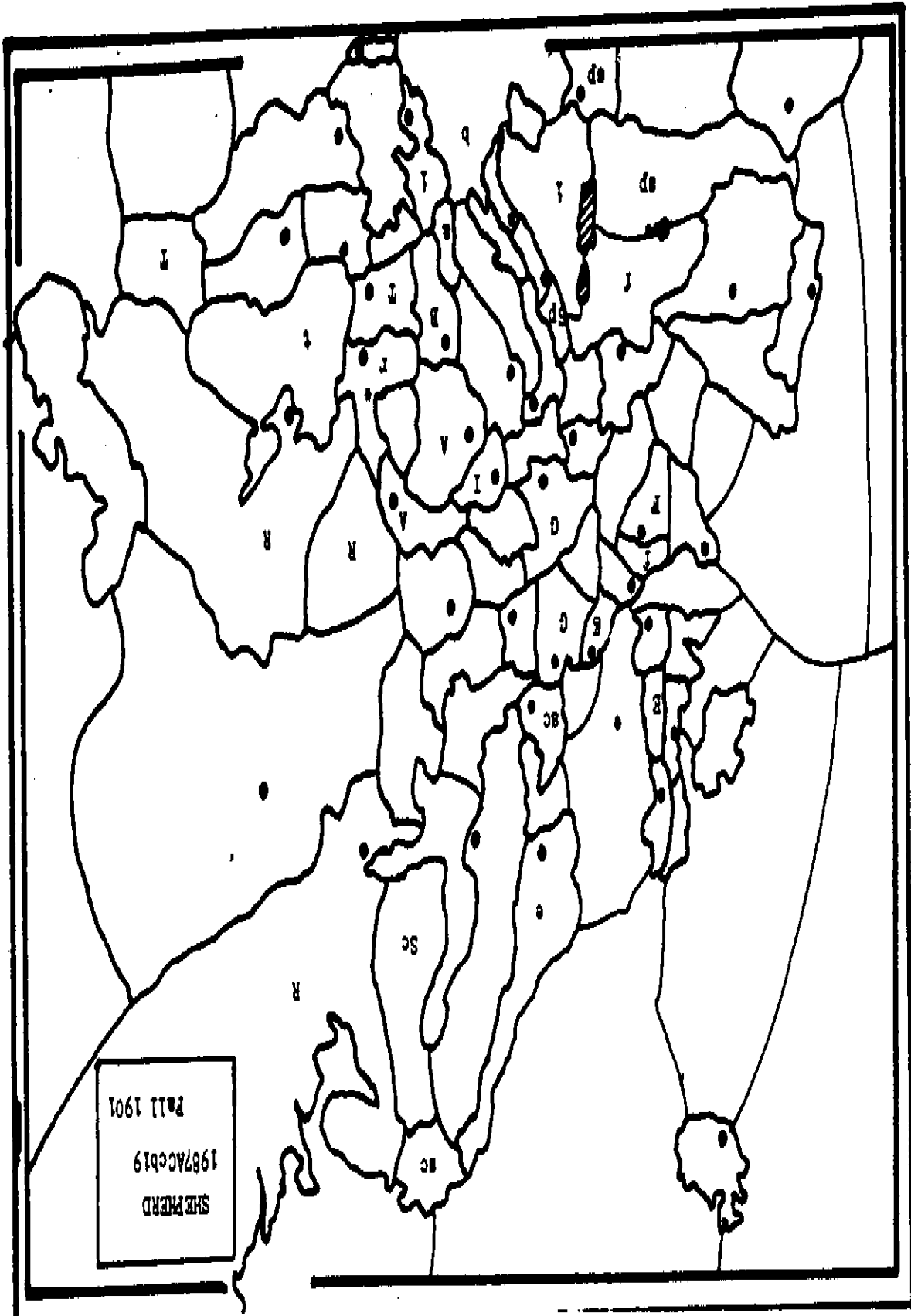

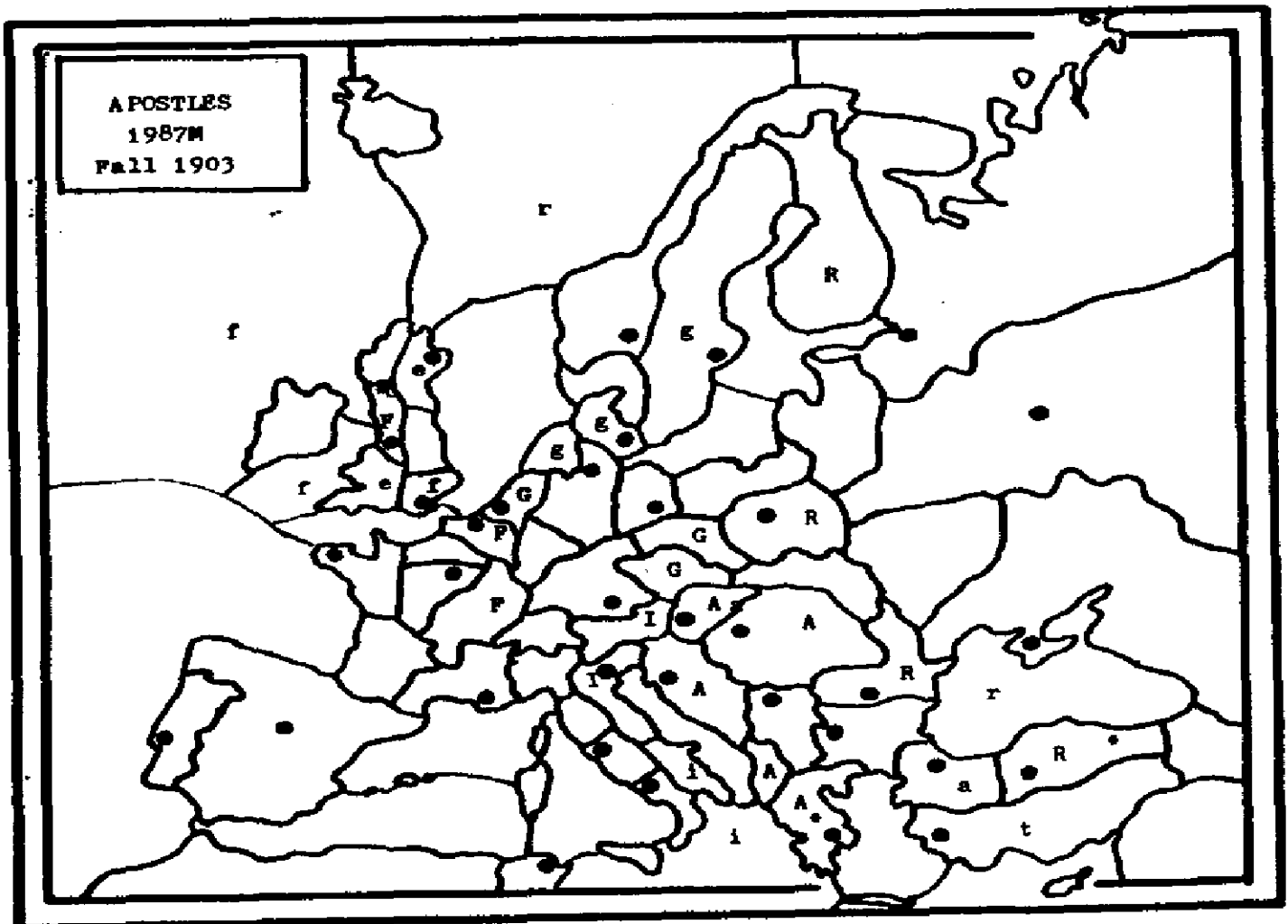
