PRESS FOR NUMBERS GAME

Moscow - September 12, 1903

Quiet has returned to the capitol now that the Bobsheviks have
control, but there is still confusion and discord across the countryside.
Ever since the sudden abduction of Czar Krebsnikov by the military, the
country has been in chaos. The new government is trying to pull itself
together, but it may well be too late to stop the forces of England,
Germany, Austria, Turkey, Japan and China that are currently massed
at, or within, its borders.
