THE HAGUE, April 2, 1909 (Reuters)

A Religious-bases faction, The Tse' Tse' Brothers, overthrew the too-long entrenched Afrikaans Party last week.

While promising to bring "'modern animism' to the oppressed people of this region", the Brotherhood's spokesman, Maurice d'Mau Mau, pledged that "no retribution" would be taken against the ex-leaders of the now defunct government, "nor their allies abroad".

Mr. d'Mau Mau, educated at the Sorbonne in Paris (PhD., Theoretical Mathematics), indicated tht he will go to Paris later this Spring for his 10th class Reunion and, while there, discuss world affairs with other heads of state.

He also hopes to discuss religious issues with the Pope and Caliph, either on his way to Paris, or while returning home after the Reunion.

Leaders of the Dutch Reformed Church here in The Hague expressed the hope that no appropriations of Afrikaans property will take place, so as to assure the success of the annual "Save the Rats" fund drive.
