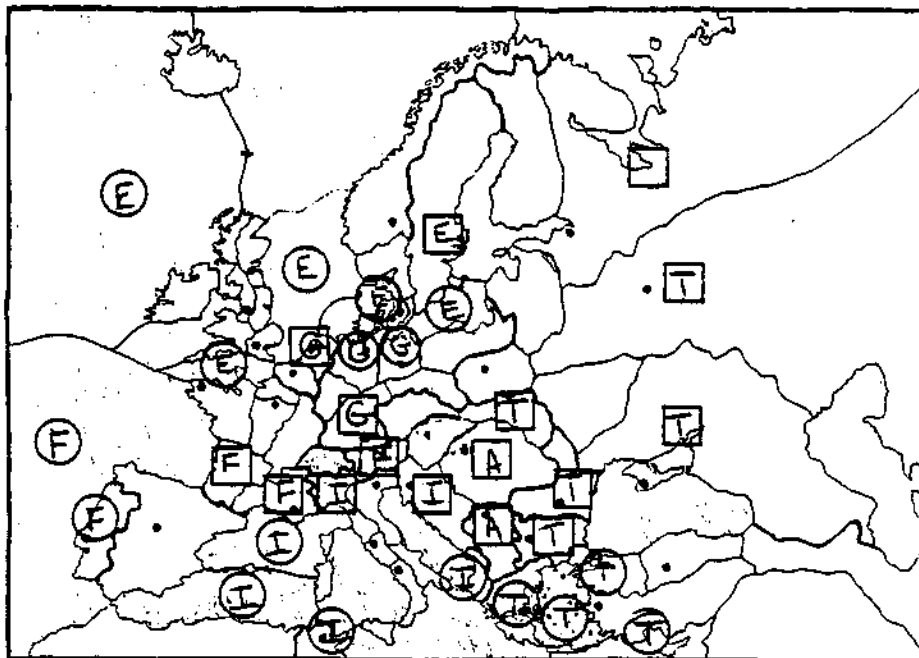

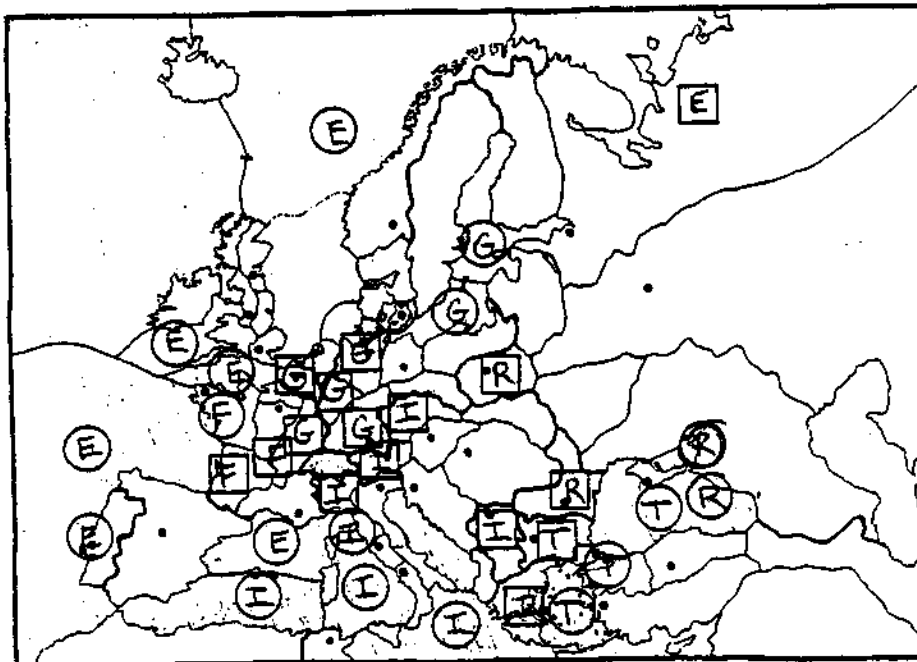

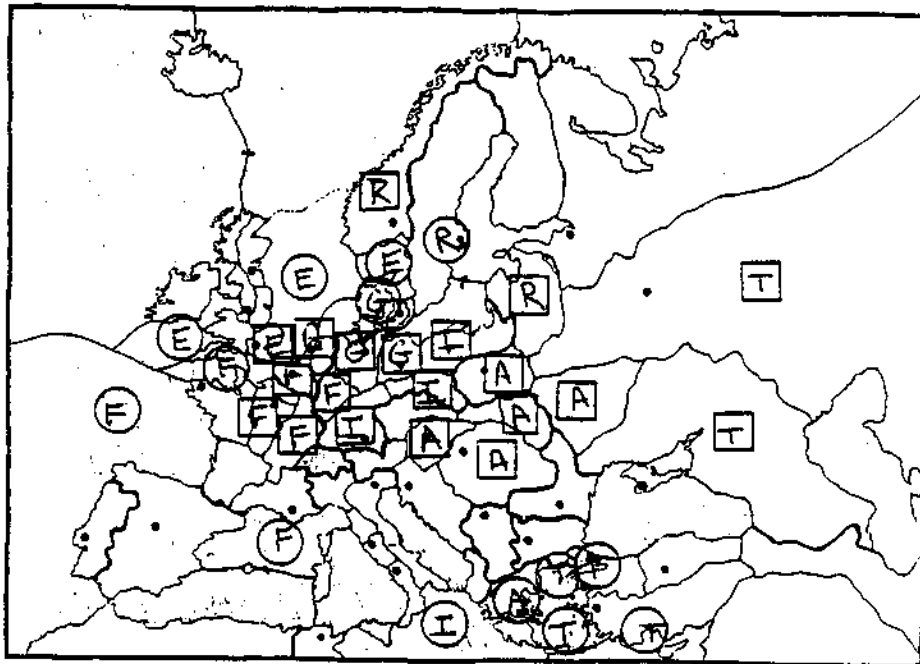

Where's Italy? Russia attacked by 4 countries; France controls the Mediterranean; England controls the Atlantic

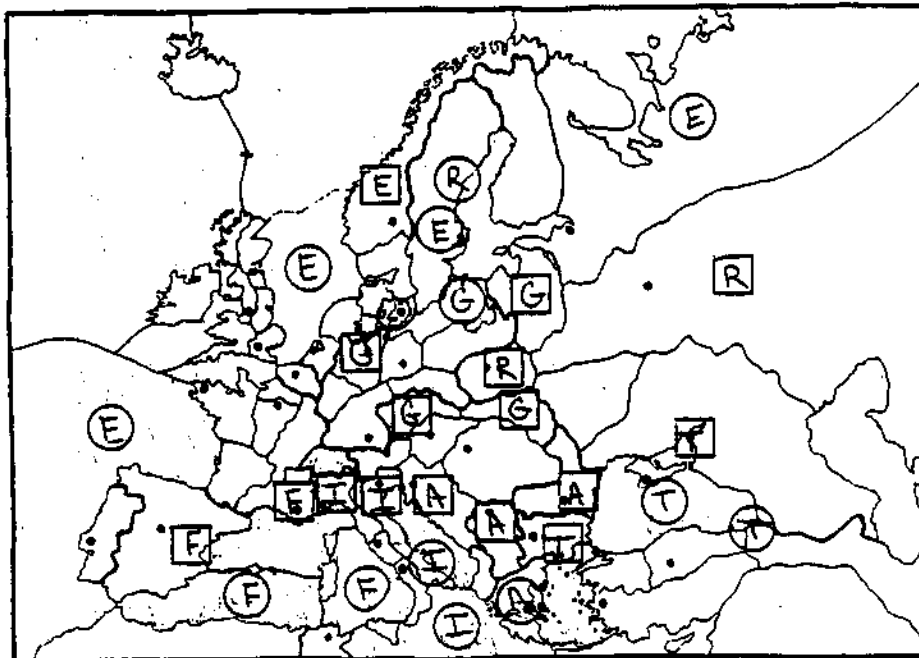

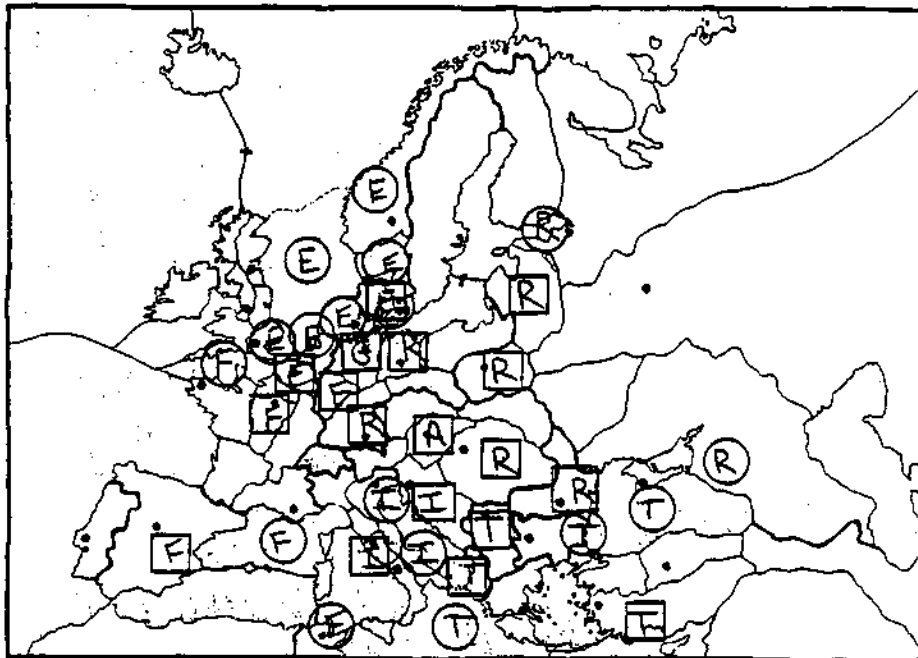

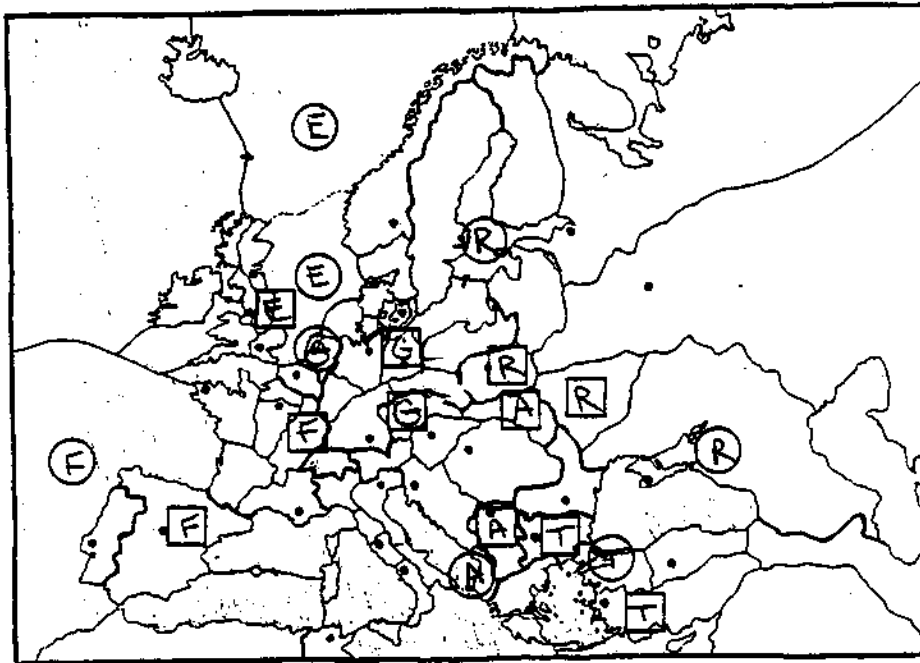

Bourse announcement

In conjunction with the Poor Richard game (1983HY), a Bourse variant will be run. The variant is open to any subscriber and is free. For those of you who do not know what a "Bourse" variant is, the rules follow. (bourse - a stock exchange in a European city, especially Paris)

1. Each player starts with 1000 units of each currency: Pounds, Francs, Lira, Crowns, Piastres, Rubles, and Marks. All are equal in value at the start of the game.
2. Deadline for bourse orders is the day before the deadline for the Diplomacy game. Orders are in two parts: Selling and buying.
3. At the start of the game, one unit of currency is worth one dollar. However, each time 100 units of any currency is sold, its value in relation to the dollar drops \$.01. Thus, in the last season the total of everyone's orders resulted in 500 more Marks being sold than bought, the price for the next season for Marks would be \$.95. Each time 100 units of any currency is bought, the price in relation to the dollar goes up \$.01.
4. All calculations are up to the player, but if the player errors, then as much of the order will be completed as possible, in the order of the purchases listed. For example, if Pounds are \$.95 and Rubles are \$1.05 and Lira are \$.85, and the player has \$100 and 100 Lira, and he orders SELL 100 Lira and buy 100 Rubles and 100 Pounds, the result: \$100 + \$.85 (lira)=\$185. Buy 100 Rubles (\$105) and buy 100 pounds (\$.95)=\$200 purchased. Actually bought would be 100 Rubles (\$105) and 89 pounds (\$.85).
5. You may never sell more than 500 units of any one currency in a given season. You may buy as much as you can.

6. Unless a country is eliminated, its currency will never drop below \$.01. The value of a currency is 0 if the country has been eliminated.
7. Bourse players must buy and sell under a "company" name. The name must be provided by the player and must be in good taste.
8. The winner of the bourse is the player who has the highest total by multiplying the amount of each currency owned by the number of supply centers owned by that country.
9. Anyone can join the bourse at anytime with 1000 units of each currency.
10. The value of each currency is additionally effected each fall season by the net gain or loss of centers by the country. One center is a change of \$.03. Two centers result in a \$.08 change and Three or more centers is a \$.15 change in value.

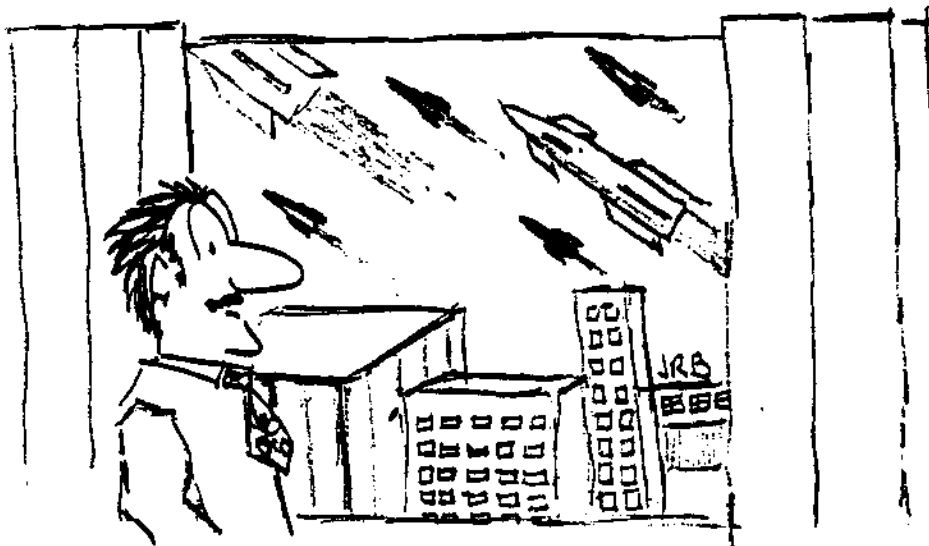
