PRESS!!!

Naples (Rooters) (For Italy or Course) - Two seaside hotels in this popular southern resort town were sacked and burned during the night in a pair of daring amphibious raids that have left local police officials baffled. Unconfirmed reports of elements of the Imperial Austro-Hungarian Navy turning pirate following the recent collapse of the Hapsburg dynasty elicited no comment from the tight lipped Austrian embassy staff here. Whatever the case, the Coast Guard has stepped up its patrols of the Tyrrhenian Sea region and units of the Third Fleet, including the battleship La Spezia, are steaming towards positions off Naples. Even the Air Force has gotten into the act, with two of its newly commissioned dreadnaught class dirigibles, the Rhiannon and the Dante Alighieri conducting round the clock surveillance of the north-western Ionian. Department of Tourism officials believe it is too early to tell whether the incident will have any adverse affects upon the area's booming vacation industry. They emphasize that authorities have the situation well under control, and that there is absolutely no danger of that problem recurring within the foreseeable future. While the raids do not appear to have cast a damper upon the city's festivities, it does appear that inland hotels are receiving an unusually high share of this year's tourist traffic.
