This ranking encompasses the four "Colonia" games for which I have final results. There is one more game that came to an official conclusion and I am trying to obtain the results of that game. Once I have that result, the Player Ranking will be up-dated and the new Ranking will be published.

There are also two other "Colonia" games which were started. One, a C-III game in Ferkin Doyles now defunct zine, was abandoned. The other apparently did not come to a conclusion, though I had thought it did. My thanks to Karl Scheutz for providing me with the final results of the three of the four games represented here.

For those of you who might be interested, the system I use to determine the rank of a given player is simply to divide his point total by the number of games he finished for a "Game-POINT - Average". The point system is also very simple: A "Single Win" is worth 90 points, plus Center Count; a "Two Way Draw" is worth 45 point plus center count to each player; a "Three Way Draw" is worth 30 plus centers and so on down the line. Survivors are credited with their center count.

Just for the record; to date there has been only one "Colonia" game played in which a "Single Win" was achieved. It was achieved by concession and that is the game I do not yet have the results for. The only information I have on that game is: Fred Hyatt played Portugal, Victor Ricci was France and Robert Stimmel was Spain. I do not know who the other players were or in what zine the game was played. Portugal won by concession.

If anyone can provide me with the final results of this game, I would be most appreciative.

The games figured in the present ranking are: 1975BKfh, 1975Ufh, 1979Lfh and 1975?fh (I can't read my own writing!! Karl, what is the other number??)

Of course, it is possible that there were "Colonia" games that I am unaware of. If such exist, I would like to know about them!!
