The zine is published on the first Saturday of each month, with orders due at 12 NOON of the publishing date, unless otherwise noted.

The subscription rate is 12\$4.00. The Game Fee is \$2.00.

The new game is filled, and the starting positions appears somewhere in these pages. I'm pleased to note that six of the positions are occupied by new subscribers.

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I've been getting quite a lot of feed-back on the "Rating System", both verbally and written. By far, the majority of those commenting prefer the original system used, or atleast a system which incorporates the #Game Point Average" concept.

The written comments : From Konrad Baumeister (culled from two separate letters) : As for "Colonia" ratings, there are short-comings to both systems thus far. I think that you might find a happy middle ground in between straight center count (which can screw the stand-by for something which was not his doing) and the modified CPCRL Lee Kendter brought up. Suppose you were to take the results from last issue and divide ~~all~~ them by numbers of games? I think that is far more accurate than simply totalling points.

Stand-by play has always been and probably always will be a problem in rating lists. All you can say is either won't rate them at all, or you rate them after they've played a significant length of time in the game, or you only rate them if their rating improves as a result, or you rate them regardless. I prefer the "time" method myself, but it's your system - you decide.

From Joe Grailey: The "Colonia Rating System" rewards quantity of play as well as quality; and encourages stand-bys to vote quickly for draws if their positions are weak. Unfortunately, the only suggestion I can come up with is adding a "games started and completed" statistic.

There is also a long article from Vernon Schall which will be fitted into the zine somewhere. (If you had TYPED it Vern, it could have been easier for me!)

Although I have not yet fixed on a method to be used, I do have a fairly good idea of what the system will be. It will definately be based on "Average Point Count". The primary problem remaining is howto deal with stand-bys, especially those stand-bys who take on a failing position to maintain some stability in a given game. For example, Gene Prosnitz has taken on a 6 center Ottoman Empire in 1975Sfh. This position is declining and it would be a miracle if it survives, let alone grows!! I can state now that Gene will NOT be rated for this position, unless he somehow manages to bring it up to a respectable finish.

Anyway, the system should be set in time to up-date the ratings when the next "Colonia" game ends.

As mentioned on Page 1, Vern sent in an article on the "Colonia Ranking
System". Since it covers one page and I'm in no mood to re-type it and
Vern's handwriting is very legible, I'm simply going to reproduce it and
include it in the zine as a page by itself.

Colonia Ranking System

I believe that any ranking system should include all of the games that an individual participates in as opposed to simply representing a ~~constant~~ cumulative total of points from different games. In other words, to compare it to baseball statistics, the rating system should be equivalent to a batting average rather than total hits. Also, as the number of completed Colonia games increases, there should be an increasingly higher minimum number of games played by an individual in order to qualify for ranking such as two games after eight competitions.

The original ranking system was criticized for encouraging a player to drop a poor position. The way to remedy this is to make a player who drops a position the player of record if the position gets into Civil Disorder or in certain other cases even further. The larger question involved in all this is how to handle standby. I would recommend that a Standby be the #1 player of record under the following circumstances: (1) the Standby takes over the position by anytime during the first two game years, (2) The Standby wins the game outright or is part of a concession draw, (3) The Standby ends the game with X number of Supply Centers (X to be defined), or (4) The Standby's finish improves his/her average ranking average assuming he/she has already completed at least one previous game. The original starting player would be the player of record in all other cases except if the ending position improved his/her average, in which case neither the starting player nor the Standby would be charged/credited with the game.

The original proposal for point assignments provided for a total of 90 points to be awarded for a victory and 1 point to be awarded for each Supply Center owned. Considering the number of Supply Centers available in Colonia II, I believe that the ratio of Victory Points (90) to Total Supply Centers (124) is too low (0.73). The second proposal of awarding 9 points for a victory and .01 points for each Supply Center results in ~~too high~~ ~~7.26~~ a ratio of 7.26 ($9/1.24$) which is too high. To my way of thinking, the second proposal significantly cheapens the survival of a 15 center Power that is not part of a Concession Draw. In my Gumbret Diplomacy Tournament that I run in DREADNOUGHT, I award 50 points for an outright victory which works to a ratio of 1.41 ($50/34$). If that same ratio were to be carried over to Colonia II, then 182 Victory Points would be awarded (assuming .01 points for each Supply Center). Victory Points should probably be expanded to 240 points for every division in case of Concession Draws.
