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MINI-BIO:

Alan Seeger (1888-1916), poet and soldier. Born on June 22, 1888 in New York City, Seeger graduated from Harvard in 1910. While in college he had contributed verse to the 'Harvard Monthly', of which he was in his final year and editor. A romantic as well as an aesthete and something of a sensualist, he found little in postgraduate life that pleased him, and in 1912 he left America for Paris. At the outbreak of World War I in August 1914 he enlisted in the French Foreign Legion. For nearly two years he served in the trenches, often volunteering for hazardous details to escape the monotony. He also continued writing poetry and send back sketches of trench life to various American journals. During the battle of the Somme in the summer of 1916 he was in the first wave over the top in the attack on the village of Belloy-en-Santerre on July 4; he was cut down by machine gun fire almost instantly. Late in the year THE POEMS OF ALAN SEEGER was published, containing his most famous verses, "Ode in Memory of the American Volunteers Fallen for France", "Champagne 1914-15" and the poem written almost in prophecy shortly before he died, "I Have a Rendezvous with Death". The volume was honored by the French Academy, and Seeger was awarded a Croix de Guerre posthumously. "Letters and Diary of Alan Seeger" appeared in 1917.

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ANOTHER MINI-BIO:

Samuel Cooper (1798-1876), Confederate army officer. Born June 12, 1798, in Hackensack, New Jersey, Cooper graduated from West Point in 1815 and was commissioned second lieutenant in the artillery. Promoted to first lieutenant in 1821, he served in various garrison posts and from 1828 to 1836 was aide-de-camp to Gen. Alexander Macomb, commanding general of the army, advancing to captain in June of the latter year. He was on staff duty in Washington, D.C. until 1841, becoming assistant adjutant general with the rank of major in 1838, and then took part in the Seminole War in Florida, 1841-1842, as chief of staff to Col. William J. Worth. Again on staff duty in Washington from 1842 to 1852, he rose to lieutenant colonel in March 1847 and was made adjutant general of the army with the rank of colonel in July 1852. In March 1861 he resigned his commission and offered his services to the Confederacy. In light of his great administrative experience, at a premium in the Confederacy, he was appointed adjutant general and inspector general of the Confederate army and in August was given the rank of general; he remained the senior officer of the army throughout the Civil War. He fled south from Richmond with President Jefferson Davis and the cabinet in April 1865 but surrendered peacefully a short time later. He later retired to an estate in Cameron, Virginia, where he died on December 3, 1876.
