MINI_BIQ:

Evans Fordyce Carlson (1896-1947), army and marine officer and author. Born on February 26, 1896, in Sidney, New York, Carlson was the son of a Congregational minister and consequently spent his childhood in various towns in New England. By fifteen he had left home and school, and in 1912, at sixteen, he enlisted in the army. After three years of service in the Philippines and Hawaii he was discharged. He was recalled in 1916 for duty in the Mexican border disturbances. He was commissioned shortly after the United States entered World War I, and he rose quickly to captain, seeing overseas duty only briefly on the staff of Gen. John J. Pershing. Resigning in 1919, he worked for a time as a salesman, but in 1922, on discovering that he could reinlist in the army only at a lower rank, he entered the marine corps instead as a private. He was commissioned second lieutenant in 1923 and after various domestic assignments was sent to Shanghai, China in 1927 as an intelligence and operations officer. That tour ended in 1929 and in 1930 he served with distinction in Nicaragua. After a second tour in Peking, China, in 1933-1935, he was promoted to captain and assigned to the military guard post at Warm Springs, Georgia, President Franklin D. Roosevel retreat. He formed there a friendship with the President that led to a private correspondence when he returned to China in 1937 as an observer with Chinese armies fighting the Japanese. He became particularly interested in the Eighth Route Army, the principal Communist force in the north of China. commanded by Chu Teh, and made two long marches with it throught the interio: His outspoken praise of the Communists' discipline, determination to oust the Japanese, and elemental democracy, contrasting sharply with the I Nationalist regime of Chiang Kai-shek, led Carlson into a dispute with his superiors that eventuated in his resignation in April 1939. For two years he traveled, in the United States and again in China; lectured on China, the Red Army, and Japan; and wrote "The Chinese Army", 1940, and "Twin Stars in China", 1940, along with periodical pieces. In April 1941 he was commissioned at his own request a major in the marine reserves, going on active duty the next month. Early in 1942 he was promoted to lieutenant

colonel in command of the 2nd Marine Raider Battalion, a picked

volunteer commando force that became known as Carlson's Raiders. Maj. James Roosevelt, the Presidents's son, Was executive officer of the battalion. Applying the lessons of the Chinese Eighth Route Army. Carlson organized the battalion on radically democratic principles, abolishing officers" mess and other privileges, issuing identical dress and equipment to all, and encouraging discussion of mission objectives and tactics both before and after execution. Carlson's Raiders went into action in August 1942 in an attack on Makin Island in the Gilbert chain, a successful raid that attracted considerable publicity. Late in that year they operated behind Japanese lines on Guadalcanal in another highly successful exploit. The Raiders battle cry was GUNG HO - a slogan actually derived from an abbreviated form of the Chinese name for an industrial cooperative society but misconstrued by Carlson as meaning "work together". Carlson's methods inevitably aroused hostility, however, and early in 1943 his Raiders were merged with three other battalions into a raider regiment with Carlson second in command. Later he was invalided home for a time. He was an observer at the landings on Tarawa in November 1943 and at the assault om Saipan in June 1944 he was badly wounded. He retired with the rank of brigadier general in July 1946 to a home in Brightwood. Oregon. continued active on behalf of U.S. -Chinese understanding, international peace and the Progressive Party until his death in Portland, Oregon on
