IMPERIAL WARCOLLEGE CORRESPONDENT COURSE. Subject: Spanish F Mnl - WPC vs SCS. From JAN LUCKENBILL: I feel as if I am aptly suited to comment on Spatn's opening. First, because I'm new to COLONIA and second because I have nover played Spain. Although I agree with Fred that political vacuum is non-existent, the question is interesting just for the sake of the bull session.

First, let us view Spain as if she were the only country in the region in question. (oversimplification is often the easiest way to broach a difficult topic) F Manila - South China Sea allows the Fleet 3 possible neutral supply centers in the Fall. F Manila - West Pacific Ocean, on the other hand, gives a choice of 5 possible supply centers. If Spain were the only country in this area, however, the entire question would be meaningless. But obviously West Pacific, on the surface, allows for more tactical flexibility.

From assuming the ideal "best" situation, ket us treat the ideal "worst" case. Assume that everyone around the regions moves in a fashinn decidedly anti-Spanish: England - F Malaya - Gulf of Siam, China - F Amoy-Bast China Sea, Portugal - F Australia - Coral Sea, Russia - F Vladivostok - Sea of Japan, Austria - F Hawaii - Polynesia (Fleets only are given consideration). Now, if Spain has moved to South China Sea, she has to outguess England and China. She has only a 1/3 shot at getting a Supply Center (true China might be supporting Russiato Japan, but that's neither here nor there). Now, China will move to Taiwan while England moves either to Cambodia or Borneo. Spain

has a 50% chance at getting a supply center.

Assume of the other hand that she had moved her Fleet to West Pacific. Austria would be moving to A) Iwo Jima or B) Guam, Ottoman to Tarawa, Portugal to New Guinea. Again, a 50% shot. With one slight difference: China and Russia each have one fleet keyed on Japan. If Russia and China stand each other out, the Spanish Fleet becomes an amazing bargaining lever in Spring 1751.

Also to be taken into consideration is the fact that South China Sea borders some prize Chinese territory: territory they may not want to give up.

All things considered, West Pacific is better because of the aforementioned facts plane, to get a 50% shot at failure in South China Sea requires only two countries to be allied against Spain, but the 50% Chance (bare minimum) in West Pacific takes "ideally bad" moves by 4 countries (either China or Russia being sufficient). How many times are 4 countries going to band together to prevent one build, at probably cost to themselves?

Thank you, Jan: Your arguements are cogent and to the point. Do I hear any disagreement?? Do I here any comments on other opening moves by other units: like the Dutch A Hague and Ottoman A Jerusalem? (You need not restrict yourselves to Spring 1750 moves, you know. Or even to the movement of one unit).
