The French Fleet on the South Coast of Spain is routed and destroyed, since France's government appears to have collapsed even more than is usual in that country.

ANNOUNCEMENT

Beginning with the 10 October 1965 issues, Massif and Trantor will be combined into one bi-weekly Diplomacy magazine, under the joint editorship of John W. Smythe and John Koning. The new magazine will continue Massif's 1965E with John Koning as Gamesmaster, and Trantor's 1964C with John Smythe as Gamesmaster. A third game, also under Smythe's auspices, will commence soon; invitations have already been issued (as is usual with YUDC-run games, admission is by invitation, since this guarantees a good player distribution and prevents geographical alliances).

Subscriptions to the new magazine (which will retain as sub-headings the old Trantor and Massif logos) are at the usual rate of 10 for \$1.00. Player copies will be sent airmail, subscription and exchange copies by first class mail.
