Being a sub-zine of UD, detailing news and information about the World-Universe Intas as it is commonly called, S-C USA 1648 Procyon ***49 man. 43/2017 INTAS as it is known by the League of Technologists.

BASIC GEOGRAPHY: Intas is a world inscribed on the inside of a cylinder. It is divided into three continents; in the "center", is the Land of Men, or Paliocria. To the east, across the mis-named Western Sea (misnamed from a sailor's point of view, anyway) is the Land of Elves, or Anachronea. To the west, or to the east beyond Anachronea lies The Land of Dwarves, or Mehico. There are no stars; the cylinder is closed at the ends. The sun is a long thin tube running the length of the cylinder. The moon, when it appears, clicks along the 42 sections in the sun/moon tube, section by section. from the north to the south.

MINOR RULES CHANGES AND EXPLANATIONS: Recently, I have experimented with allowing all persons to advance simulatenously in as many disciplines as he liked (thus, for instance, a person might be a Paladin/Magic-User/Cleric/Thief/Martial Artist/Lancer/Assasin or somesuch.) However, this is unwieldly. Now, the following rule is in effect: When a player rolls for his character, he chooses a Primary Discipline for his character (fighter or what have you.) Then, if, after switching points from one requisite to another, that character has 15 or above (or 6 or below in the case of Empaths) in a given Prime Requisite, he may choose one Discipline with that characteristic as its Prime Requisite as a Secondary Discipline. Thus, a fighter with a dexterity of 15 may become a Fighter/Thief. All persons who currently have experience in a discipline which, by these rules may no longer participate in will have all experience transferred from that discipline to a Discipline of his choice.

Note the following restrictions still apply: All Armor restrictions: thus, a Martial artist/~~xx~~Cleric cannot wear any armor because he is a Martial Artist. A cleric (whether such Primarily or Secondarily) may use any kind of edged weapon. A Magic User may only use daggers and Martial Artist weaponry.

INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS

Holy Church: All chaotic and lawful clerics belong to this church. Benefits: Any dead cleric is guaranteed to be raised if his body has been dragged to the cathedral or whatnot. Out-of-work clerics can usually find a job. Dues: A tithe of ten per-cent of a cleric's worldly goods, to be paid each 52nd week. Note that this includes magical items.

Paladin's League: Any paladin may join. Ray Heuer (Glade) is currently the head of the Ambrusial Chapter. Benefits: Can provide good deeds to perform and missions to make. Semi-Annual Banquet. Provides Sex Anonymous, a service for Paladins who are Sorely Tempted. Dues: Whatever you can give.

Brotherhood of Rangers: Not a formal organization. A Ranger in need may, using the secret recognition signals, gain help from any brother Ranger.

Thieves Guild: Benefits: Training. Nothing else, exactly; however, if you are operating as a thief and the Thieves Guild catches you, you are liable to lose your eyes, hands, nose, ear and/or balls. Dues: 10 percent of everything you get, Jack.

Assassin's Guild: Benefits: See above. Also, can provide special Assassin's Weapon for a nominal fee. Steve Whitmore (name withheld) is apparently the head. Dues: 50 G.P. per year per level.

Gay Liberation Front: Organization of persons of the alignment Fagget. Benefits: Various and sundry. Dues: 20 G.P. per level per year.

Organization of Pimps, Prostitutes and Brother Owners (OPPEO): All persons of the Harlot class must join. Penalties? See Thieves. Benefits: Can always find you work. Dues: 10% of anything you get through OPPEO.

Technologists Union: Don't call us, we'll call you. Underground organization. Benefits: Unknow. Dues: Unknow. Purpose: Unknow.

Communist Underground: Obvious

Anit-Paladins League: Benefits: Liason with OPPBO. Can provide horrible deeds to perform. Semi-Daily Orgy. Dues: As much as they can possibly squeeze out of you.

Society for Creative Anachronism (Intas Kingdom): Benefits: Instruction in sword play. Jousting experience. Can provide members with nice little anachronisms like a Colt 45. Suspect liason with Technologists' Union. Dues: 100 G.P. per year per level.

Law for Jesus: Self-explanatory, Composed of converted Chaotics.

TAVERNS IN THE CITY OF AMBRUSIL

The Green Slime Inn--10 G.P. per month. Greasy food. Lousy (in the original sense) beds. Green Slime on the water. The chamber pots are NEVER changed. Crime Rate in the Inn Proper: 99.999% (The thieves guild missed one Elric of Melnibone last year when he converted three thieves into little white crumbly polygons.)

The Paladin's Sword: 25 G.P. per month. Relatively good food. Suspected to be a covert meeting place for the outlawed Gay Liberation Front. Known to be favorite hangout of Paladins (make your own conclusions.) Decent food.

Camp Keewasawe Tent and Trailer Park: 1 G.P. per week. One of a chain dotted all over the Empire of Bozart and the Four and One Half Kingdoms. No food.

Flanagan's Place: Good Irish bar. Steaks. 15 G.P. per month. Known for the unintelligent nature of the conversation that takes place on the Friday Night Punning Session.

The White Hart: Relatively good food. Excellent bar. 15 G.P. per month.

The Broken Bench: Lousy beds, medium good food. Mostly known for the ferocious Saturday night brawls. People come from all around the county to fight. 12 G.P. per month plus cost of broken furniture etc.

The Monastery: Not an inn. Provided by Holy Church for the comfort of clergy. Clergy must, of course, provide the usual "free will" offering of 10 G.P. per month to the ~~Deacons~~ Deacons. A Legion of "Fallen Sisters" is held at the ready for those clerics who feel a "spiritual" need.

Prices range between 1 S.P. and 1000 G.P. depending on the quality, quantity and type of service desired. Mother Hussans has a reputation for honesty.

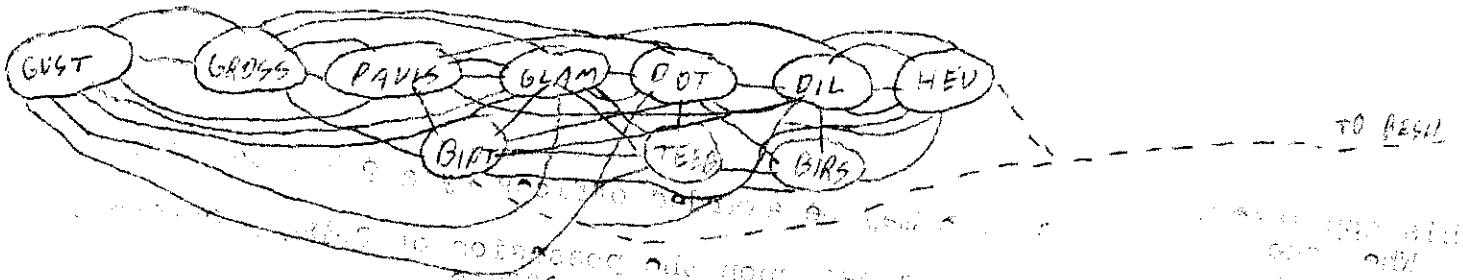
ALL PLAYERS ARE REQUESTED TO NAME A PLACE OF RESIDENCE.

NEWS

Castle Vale and the Haphaestan Border Castle have recently been destroyed by a roving company of villains, seemingly based in Ambrusil. In the latter, they apparently had the complicity of a large number of Haphaestan barbarians. It is said that a Paladin accompanied the villains, but this seems improbable; Paladins don't do that sort of thing.

The 1st Bank of Hastanburn was robbed recently in a daring mid-night theft. It is believed that a cleric named Liviu Storr (Sigmund) along with a pack of Displacer Beasts knocked the bank over. The safe was apparently smashed, and the money removed. The Mayor of Hastanburn reports that a good amount of the Family Fortune was stolen during the night as well. This seems most odd as Displacer Beasts do not travel in packs, and there is no way that the safe should have been smashed as it was. The authorities are investigating.



THE CHARTER OF THE NEW YORK CONSPIRACY

Preamble:

We, the superior people of the Greater New York area, having full faith in our innate superiority over all other beings, and in our manifest destiny to rule the world, do hereby ordain and establish this charter of the New York Conspiracy. In order to further our ambitions, and to impose what we see as a logical and inevitable form of government over the people of the world, and to concentrate the global reins of power in our hands, we hereby declare ourselves the true masters of the world.

ARTICLE I Membership

The New York Conspiracy (hereafter the Conspiracy) shall consist of all members. All Directors, puppets, and Conspirators shall be members.

ARTICLE II Ranks

The Conspiracy shall consist of members of various ranks, each rank having particular requirements, rights, and responsibilities. The ranks are:

Conspirator: [Each conspirator shall have] 1/2 vote; any person within the Region may become a Conspirator by informing the Membership Secretary of his desire to do so; [a Conspirator] receives a conspiracy name from the Factotum Lingua Conspiratoria Novum Eboracum (Nomenclature.)

Puppet: 1 vote; appointed by a Director; receives puppethood in Order of his appointer.

Secondary Director: [such a Director has] 2 votes; [he] must have been a Conspirator who is nominated and then elected Secondary Director by a majority vote of the Conspiracy; [he] receives a Coat of Arms from the Chief of the Moralistic College and becomes Master of an Order (which he must name); can appoint 1 puppet; May also attain rank by purge.

Special Director: has 3 votes. Must be nominated and then elected Special Director by 2/3's vote of the Primary Directors; receives, if not previously a Secondary Director, a Coat of Arms and an Order. Can appoint 2 puppets. May also attain rank by purge.

Primary Director: 5 votes. Must either be proposed by a Conspirator or Director who is proposed by 12 or more votes and is then elected by a majority of the primary Directors. Receives, if not previously a Secondary or Special Director, a Coat of Arms and becomes Master of an Order; can appoint 3 puppets. May also attain rank by purge.

A Member shall be considered to be nominated [for some rank] when a statement nominating him shall have been printed in a newsletter.

ARTICLE III Titles, Orders, and Offices

In addition to a Conspiracy name, members of the Conspiracy will receive titles, orders, and offices.

When one is elected a Director for the first time, one may give oneself a title; any others must be awarded by a majority vote of the Conspiracy. When one accepts a puppethood, one receives membership in the Order of

If, within the vote deadline for the Vote of Confidence for a purge, the Vote Recorder receives written notice from the puppet that he, the puppet no longer desires to conduct a purge, the purge shall be considered to have been denied. The results of a denied purge shall be ~~xxxxx~~ the same as the results of a failed purge, although the Vote Recorder must print notice that it was denied.

ARTICLE VII Resignation and Refusal

The Conspiracy is a participation-oriented organization. Therefore, at any time and in any and all offices, ranks, and puppethoods may be either resigned or refused. If one resigns from a Directorship, one becomes a Conspirator. If one resigns from Conspiratorship, one is removed from all aspects of the Conspiracy, and loses all things one may have received from the Conspiracy.

ARTICLE VIII Region

All members of the Conspiracy, except Special Directors, must reside within the states of Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York, Connecticut, Rhode Island, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Vermont or Maine for some part of the year.

ARTICLE IX Resolutions and Motions

Any Resolution or Motion proposed in a newsletter shall be adopted and passed if it receives a majority vote of all members.

ARTICLE X Voting

All votes must be ~~sent~~ to the Vote Recorder to be valid.

For purposes of the Charter, a majority vote shall consist of more than half of the legitimate votes cast; a 2/3's vote shall consist of more than 2/3 of the votes cast. [What about 3/4 votes?]

ARTICLE XI Amendments

This charter may be amended only by a vote of 3/4 of those eligible to vote. [Actually what he means is that the Charter can be amended only by a 3/4 of those votes cast; Thus, a primary Director casts 5 votes while a Conspirator casts 1/2, and so on.]

Article XII Primary Offices

The following Primary Offices are hereby established and assigned to the named individuals until such time as they choose to resign them [or, assumedly, are purged]

MEMBERSHIP SECRETARY- Shall be in charge of all matters of names, titles, ranks, offices and whatnot that is included in the membership list. The membership list is available for an SASE. This office and a Primary Directorship are assigned to Ben Grossman.

VOTE RECORDER- shall be in charge of all votes. Publishes the Vote Recorder Newsletter. He will inform any who request information about completed votes for an SASE. A Primary Directorship and this office go to Jeremy Paulson. [What about Jerry? Why are we leaving him out?]

GRAND INQUISITOR- shall be in charge of all matters of enforcing this Charter, the punishment of crimes, and other matters of jurisprudence. He must appoint 2 INQUISITORS who shall help deliberate cases, and may appoint 2 QUISITORS, also to help deliberate, in major cases. He shall run the Inquisition. This office and a Primary Directorship are assigned to Greg Costikyan.

ARTICLE XIII Secondary Offices

[Grossman doesn't say anything about what the following are, he merely presents a list; however, for the sake of argument we shall assume that the following are Secondary Offices.]

Keeper of the Number of the Swiss Bank Account

Factotum de Lingua Conspiratoria Novum Eboracum (Nomenclature.) Shall assign a name to each new Conspirator or out-of-region Special Director.

Factotum de Lingua Conspiratoria Novum Eboracum (Verbum). Invents new words for the Lingua Conspiratoria Novum Ebroacum shall print a dictionary of words at least yearly, to be available at Postage Cost.

Chief of the Heraldic Collgge. Assignes Coats of Arms to Directors. Copies of individual or all the Coats of Arms are available for cost of postage and color photocopy.

ARTICLE XIV Inquisition [NOBODY expects the Duddish Inquisition!]

The following special offices are hereby established:

INQUISITOR: Appointed by the Grand Inquisitor. Each recieves 1 vote in the Star Chamber. There are 2 Inquisitors.

QUISITOR: Appointed by the Grand Inquisitor to held in important cases, the each recieve 1 vote in the Court of Star Chamber. There are 2 Quisitors.

Both Inquisitors and Quisitors may be removed by the Grand Inquisitor after serving at least 4 months.

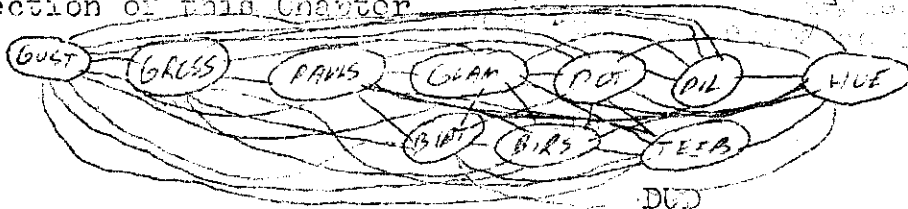
The Court of Star Chamber shall consist of ~~xxx~~ the Grand Inquisitor, both Inquisitors, and the Quisitors if any of them feels that they are needed. The Court of Star Chamber shall rule on any matters brought before it by either Grand Inquisitor, Inquisitor, or other member of the Conspiracy.

The Grand Inquisitor shall determine procedure on all matters, but he may be overuled by both Inquisitors together.

The Grand Inquisitor has the power to rule any matter not specified as an Inquisition Crime as being irrelevant and dismiss the motion entirely.

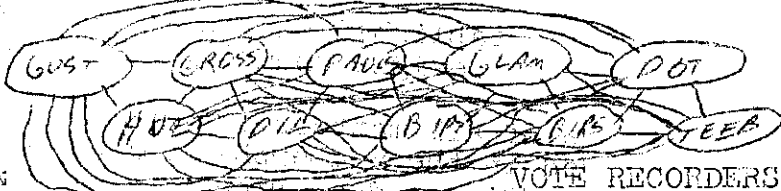

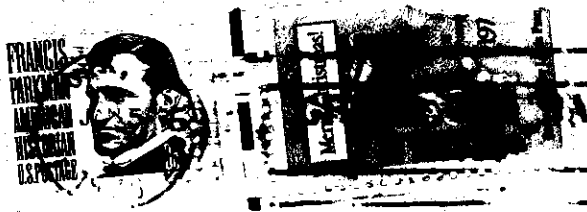
