ues this newsletter whenever there is time and need for it. Interested people outside of the PDRC may subscribe at the rate of 20¢ per issue, but are warned ahead of time that they won't necessarily be getting huge issues every time. A copy of this also goes free to the Archives. This is EGGNOG Enterprises Production #102.

This is the Constitution issue of VANTLLA FUDGE; it contains that and only that. Other PDRC business will be discussed in the next issue, which I'll probably type up tomorrow or the day afterwards. (I intend to send these issues out together.) The PDRC Constitution was originally published in Lagutas #12 & 14 (by Rod Walker). More on that later.

## CONSTITUTION

I. The Postal Diplomacy Rating Commission is a voluntary association of postal Diplomacy Ratingsmasters and other persons. Its purpose is the achievement of common policies and decisions relative to the rating of postal Diplomacy games. Such decisions are not automatically binding on the members (unless otherwise specified in this Constitution), but represent guidelines only.

II. Membarship. The following individuals are eligible to be mem-

bers of the PDRC:

A. Ratingsmasters. Any person who maintains a rating system for regular postal Diplomacy games, and has published his rating list at least once in a postal Diplomacy 'zine of general circulation, and who continues to update his list and publish the updated list at least twice annually, may be a member. The requirement for updating the list is contingent upon timely publication of completed game statistics by the Boardman Number Custodian.

B. The Baardman Number Custodian.

III. Any member who no longer meets the qualifications of membership is no longer a member, and his membership may be terminated by the Chairman. The Chairman must give advance notice of his intended action to the individual involved and must allow reasonable time for a reply or corrective action.

IV. The Chairman may be any member elected to that office. He will organize and conduct the business of the PDRC, and will publish the PDRC business publication. He must publish it at least once each 8 weeks. He is elected by majority vote. Once elected, he serves until his resignation or removal.

W. Members must vote and return every ballot sent them by the Chairman. Failure to do so may be excused on the grounds of postal failure or personal emergency; however, the Chairman will make every effort to obtain a completed ballot after the stated deadline in such instances.

VI. Standard Reting Base (SRB):

A. The SRB will include every game which the PDRC determines
to be a "regular postel Diplomacy game". This listing will be published
periodically in postel Diplomacy 'sines of general circulation.

B. The PDRC may vote to exclude all games of a certain type ("Category") from the SRB. It may declare an individual game to be within an excluded category, or it may wate to exclude a game from the SRB

on individual grounds.

C. The vote to exclude a category from the SRE, or to place a game within an excluded category, or to include a formerly excluded game in the SRB, will be unaniaous with one dissent, but two dissents will be allowed if the membership of the PDRC is 8 (eight) or more (ABO/ABT).

D. An individual performance within a game otherwise within

the SRB may be excluded by a vote of ABO/ABT.

VIII. All votes required in this document specify a majority of the whole membership; that is, votes not east are counted in the negative.
VIII. This Constitution will be adopted when it receives an affirm-
