FOR ANYONE WHO MISSED IT LAST TIME those houserules were a joke last issue. We here in Whitestonia prefer to run games without any rules, aside from the rulebook. Those were a joke. We think it was funny, do you?

HOBBY NEWS: Please vote in the John Leeder poll of zines and GMs this year. This is a yearly poll to see who is who in the Diplomacy hobby. THE BLACK HOLE AFFAIR. This is Dave Barker's side to the story. Last issue you heard Matt McGibbon's version. This is the viewpoint of David Barker, not the publisher.

Last October Bruce Linsey sent me a copy of his first issue of The Voice of Doom. I was quite impressed with what I saw and I wrote Bruce to tell him so. And I sent him my subscription check and game fee and entered a game. Before the game began, Linsey called all of us to see whether we wanted to play in a southern California game. We all agreed. Linsey apparently didn't have my phone number, though, so he called Matt McGlbbon to get it from him. Unfortunately, Matt had it, since we go to school together, and gave it to him. Later I scolded Matt for this, since I don't like people giving out my phone number without permission. Anyway, Matt was over at my house one night a while after the game started and at that time I got a call from Jack Masters, the English player. Jack and I discussed several tactical options for the first few years, and Jack also mentioned that Linsey had told him that McGibbon had given Linsey my phone number. This puzzled me, because I figured Linsey was a fair GM and would not do something like this. Jack pressed me as to why Matt had my number, and I was forced to tell him the truth, that we both go to Fullerton State and live in the same dorm. I hoped that Jack's knowing that information would not bias the game. Too bad for us and for Linsey, it did.

Shortly after the phone call, Matt and I heard from the other players that they knew we had a strong alliance because we go to school together. There was little we could do about it, because Jack Masters has been in the hobby for years and was able to convince everyone else that we were allied. This, clearly, prejudiced the game in favor of all the other countries and against us, and Linsey was at fault for giving his crony Jack Masters that knowledge.

There is no excuse for Linsey having done this, and when Matt inquired about it, Linsey and Masters had a quick phone conversation during which it was agreed that neither would remember saying anything of the sort. After persuading Masters that this was the best way to go, Linsey then talked to me and Matt with his bullshit story about never having said anysuch thing. I don't think it was really ethical of Masters to agree to cover this error of Linsey's up, but Linsey is the real culprit here. He is so sly and clever that I think he convinced Masters that his (Masters) reputation would suffer as well if word got out. That's why Masters went along with the lie. Masters does anything that Linsey says to this day. He writes articles for The Voice of Doom because Linsey has convinced him that it would give him the best publicity to do so. Linsey talked Masters into going along with the story that Linsey lived in California for seven years, a story Linsey made up to give credibility to his friendship with Jack.

Linsey later told me point blank to resign from the game or get kicked out, which he had just done to Matt. Under this threat, I stepped down. I feel it is totally unethical for a GN to do what Linsey did. He gave me an ultimatum to get out, and if anybody wants to see a xerox copy of it, I'll be glad to send it. Here are my notes on the above. These are the facts as they appear in VOD. In #6, Matt McGibbon gets kicked out for supposedly lying to the GM. In #8, England and Barker resign their positions. Barker did so under duress. #11, it is announced that John Kelley (another of Linsey's henchmen) takes over Turkey, from Barker. Is this coincidence? Is the Pope Jewish? Jack Masters resigned in #8 because Linsey told him it would be best. Kathy Byrne was ejected from her VOD game (for all practical purposes) because she disagreed with Linsey. Linsey has since told Dave White to get lost because he disagrees too. Linsey does not tolerate anybody disagreeing with him.

Now some more facts from #15. Two more players in another game listed as thrown out. Three more have resigned, one from the Black Hole game. Why? Is this Linsey's doing. or is it coincidence? Linsey has mentioned that new games will be restricted to current VOD players. We think that Linsey might be pulling a Bernie Oaklyn and signing up aliases for his games. All players are urged to beware before signing up for a game in Voice of Doom. Those are the facts. You may draw your own conclusions based on them.
