

DIPLOMACY PLAYERS ASSUCIATION (PROPOSED)

After rending the article by Jerry Jones in the Diplomacy World last year concerning the need for a Diplomacy Players Association (DNA), I wrote Jerry to may I would help get this started in any way he saw fit to use me. After several letters with Jerry and conversations with several other hollby members, it resolved to a state where Jerry did not have the time he expected and needed to put into the development of the DPA, and Jerry asked that I take over organizing the DPA.

My position on all this is that a DPA is needed to . olve a number of current problems that affect players and to respond to new problems that arise in the hobby that players should take an active interest in based on self-interest. I personally, as a publisher and player, see the need for such a group, but I feel that I should not take a major role in the group after it gets started. The following is some of my thoughts on a proposed DPA for your review.

The following are the proposed activities of the Diplomacy Players Association:

1) Operation of the Diplomacy Arbitration Board (discussion attached);

2) Sanction of various hobby-wide elections including the Diplomacy Players Poll

started by John Caruso last year;

3) Establishment of a Player/G/1 Houserules Committee to develop a model set of play-by-mail houserules which are approved by the DPA for possible use or modification by new (and old if they desire) publishers; 4) Election of a CPA Ombudsman to represent the hobby-wide players in matters that

they deem appropriate.

In addition to these areas, the DPA will serve as a group which can react to any major new problem that develops within the hobby and serve to be a voice for active players in matters of interest.

A governing body for the DPA would be selected by hobby-wide elections each Nominations for any position on the Council would be accepted in the month of September each year. In early October, all nominees would be contacted to verify that they would consent to serve if elected. In mid-October a ballot would be sent to all publishers with the request that the election be publicized; the ballot would contact the names of all those nominated plus space for write-in candidates. Voting would be open to all Diplomacy players, and votes would be accepted from November through December. The votes would be tabulated and certified, and the elected candidates would take office on January 1.

The Council would be made up of seven (7) members: DPA President, responsible for overseeing the council, appointing special committees, and general administrative duties; DPA Secretary, to handle all major correspondence, press releases, reports, and ballots; DPA Ombudsman, to serve as Ombudsman in an elected capacity as a general serve to the Diplomacy hobby; Head of the Diplomacy Arbitration Board (DAB), to coordinate the DAB services (as described elsewhere); DPA Elections Supervisor, to sanction any OPA approved elections and prepare all materials, count ballots, and other election supervision activites; and two General Council members. The offices of DPA President, Secretary, Ombudsman, and Elections Superviser make be held only by Players. Publishers and GMs will be allowed to serve in the other three posts if elected. Term of office would be from Jan. 1 to Dec. 31 of each year. The President and Elections Superviser would not be allowed to succeed themselves.

There would be no fee associated with membership in the DPA. Anyone who cares to call themselves an active player would be allowed to participate.

hight now I need two things from hobby members. First is reaction and suggestions about the above and the attached materials on the DAB. The second is for some volunteers to assist in starting the DPA and serving until elections at the end of the year. Hopefully the DPA can get off the ground in the late Spring or Summer and be into smooth operations for the elections this fall.

DIPLOMACY ARBITRATION BOARD

- 1. Why? There have arisen in past years many conflicts between and among players, publishers, and game masters concerning matters of the game of Diplomacy. In the past, a large number have been settled to the satisfaction of the involved parties through such manners as writing Alan Calhamer, contacting Avalon Hill, using an ombudsman, selecting a disinterested party to review the matter, or just flipping a coin. Unfortunately, in many other cases, the issues were not resolved because there was not an established mechanism to help settle disputes; thus a number of hobby feuds were started, and most of these continue to the detriment of the hobby. To allow for another channel for parties interested in settling these and future disputes in an organized and impartial manner, a Diplomacy Arbitration Board (DAB) should be established.
- 2. When should the DAB be used? The DAB will be available to players, publishers, and game masters to settle any dispute that is mutually agreed to be submitted to the arbitration procedure. This includes, but is not limited to: rule interpretations, houserule conflicts, player/publisher/GM misconduct, and unethical practices. The major point is that all involved parties must agree in writing to have the matter settled by this procedure; the DAB has no desire to seek out conflicts nor accept questions presented by only one side. If the involved parties believe the issue is one which should be settled by the DAB, the DAB will accept the issue. If the involved parties are not agreed to the procedure, then the DAB has no desire to be contacted.
- 3. What is the procedure? Well, there are two major components to the arbitration system. The first component concerns the agreement to arbitration and submission of materials. Upon receiving a request to arbitrate, the DAB will contact the involved parties separately and ask for written confirmation that all parties agree to submit the question to arbitration and initiate the selection procedure. (discussed below). Upon receiving positive answers from each of the involved parties, each will be asked to summarize its position and furnish any materials or other data which should be reviewed by those selected for the decision panel. After these materials, are received by the DAB, a total packet of information on the issue willbe sent to the decision panel. The second major area concerns the composition of the decision
- panel. When the involved parties are first contacted concerning their agreement to the arbitration procedure, the DAB will randomly select from those on its rosters who have agreed to serve on decison panels four players and three CN/publishers. This list of seven individuals will be sent to each of the two sides, and each side will be allowed to remove two persons without cause. If the two sides do not take full advantage of the deletions or remove the same person, the resulting number of valid persons will be reduced to three by lot. These three individuals will make up the decision panel for the issue. The decision panel will review the materials submitted, be allowed to request additional information, and give a decision to the DAB in writing. The DAB will send the copies of the decision to the involved parties.
- 4. What is the make-up of the individuals who will serve on the decision panels? The DAB will seek out volunteers from throughtout the hobby to serve on the decision panels. Publicity will be sought through all channels possible. Those individuals who are now publishing or have published a zine in the past as well as current and past GNs will be on the Publisher/GN list. Any person who plays postal Diplomacy and does not fall into the above group will be placed on the player list.
- 5. Is the DAB associated with any Diplomacy organization? The DAB is established to service the players of postal Diplomacy and as a framework is incorporated into the Diplomacy Players Association. The DAB is not associated with any other group. By seeking volunteers throughout the hobby, the DAB is hopefully to be non-political in nature as much as possible.
- ((As a concerned player and publisher, I see a need for such a association. I am in support of Al, and will lend any hend to him that he requests. May I ask fellow publishers to at least mention this in their zines. You need not be in agreement, or even support the ideas. It is just requested of you to inform your players and let them decide for themselves if they want to know more. All info requests should be directed to Al Pearson Rt 1 Box 177 B5 Kearneysville, W Va 25430. Hobby services are not for a choice few. They are for all. Please mention this in your zine. Thank you.))






