I do not actually demand any type of good reference since I would not want to exclude a possable concientous or reliable novice, what I am looking for is a lack of bad references. To those of you who take offence at this, once again all I can do is apologize.

Next I would like to thank those of you that have offered to trade however for the most part I have decided not to get involved in any trades at the present time. I am interested in keeping a relatively small sub list and as a result I do not want to increase it to quickly by virtue of trades. I mean no disrespect nor any typeof insult to those of you who offered (I was really amazed as well as a little flattered at how many of you actualy offered) however at present trades simply dont fit into my plans. Also considering the number of misspellings as well as typos that I will have I would doubt that I could offer you the same quality product that you would be offering me unless of course you wind up in a game here.

Lets see, what next? Oh yea, people and their habits of printing and not printing letters. In all cases anyone will have their wishes respected as far as the publication of any mail sent to me regarding this zine. Any and all letters addressed to Russ will be considered personal and not for print. All letters regarding a game will be considered personal and not for print. If people wish to adjust this list by either getting on or off it please let me know as soon as possable. I know others were interested, unfortunately I cant remember who you are. As long as most of the publishers around nowadays (at least the ones that I sub to) seem to be donating time to music revues and because I need more filler in order to lengthen this thing I will do the same. Instead of talking about a new album though, I would like to more or less revue a concert (and to some degree the trouble I had getting there) that I attended on May 14.

The concert I am referring to was billed as The Turtles, featuring Flo & Eddie. For those of you asking who are they, dont feel left out considering most of the people I mentioned it to when I was trying to get others interested in going said basicly the same thing. Actualy when I saw the advertisement in the paper I decided I definately had to go since the best concert I had seem was 7 years earlier by Flo & Eddie. Now after 7 years they were back in Chicago and there was no way I was going to miss it. The only problem now was to get someone else to come. I had one good friend that wanted to go but his wife wouldnt let him out. On the other hand most of the people I know wanted no part of the show whatsoever considering my taste in music. Even the fact that it was being held at the Park West (considered a very good nightclub in Chicago) wouldnt sway anyone. (Lest you think I am the only one in the hobby that was interested, Paul Rauterburg later told me that he wished he had known they were here because he would have gladly driven down) Eventualy a girl from our bowling league agreed to go just because she was curious about what I was raving about.

For those of you who are still wondering who the Turtles are, they are a rock band or group if you wish that was big in the mid and maybe late 60s. After breaking up the two lead vocalists Mark Vollman (Flo) & Howard Kaylan (Eddie) started singing with Frank Zappa and the Mothers of Invention in the early 70s. After leaving Zappa these two singers struck out on their own as Flo & Eddie. (Apparently they were not allowed to use the name the Turtles due to contract problems) The first time I had seen them they had combined the happy go lucky style of the Turtles with the ?????? style of Frank Zappa to come up with an excellent show that was well balanced between music and a baser sort of comedy. Although they are now back to calling themselves the Turtles they have retained the style of play that developed when they were known as Flo & Eddie.

Anyway having finaly gotten someone to come with me I got to the second show of the evening. After listening to a typical opening rock band of three guitars and a drummer whose musix only real quality was to be loud enough to drown out any vocals there might have been we were ready for the main event. After about 20 minutes of setup time the Turtles were finaly on stage and I was sitting only about 5 feet away from the stage. When they did appear the first thing you noticed was the sling on Flo's right arm which was cause for disappointment since a big part of the show is made up of his "acrobatacs" as well as his imitations of famous rock guitar players. In any case he still did his best as far as the physical part of his performance as well as replacing his imitations of famous guitarists with a takeoff on Jim Morrison. The show consisted mostly of old Turtles songs as well as some material done with Zappa and some of the songs put out under the Flo & Eddie titles. They also decided to do pieces from the childrens Strawberry Shortcake soundtracks explaining that had written all of this material as well as received Grammys for it. The best part of the show in my opinion was their performance of the Hippopatomous Limbo as well as getting the entire audience to join in an extra long version of Happy Together. Another interesting part was listening to Flo explain how his teenage daughter just had to have the new U-2 album and how much of a boost to his morale her total lack of interest in his music provided.

When I went to this show I was really in kind of a miserable mood considering I had just learned I would be out of a job soon, I had just finished getting screwed in court (my opinion of course), my Diplomacy games were all going sour, not to mention having struck out with so many people trying to get someone to join me. When I left the Park West I felt better then I had in a long while, the show just left me in a fantastic mood. In my opinion it was worth every penny spent and I would urge anyone seeing either Flo & Eddie or the Turtles billed anywhere near them to make a point of getting to the show.

A responce to those of you who took the time to respond with sympathetic, supportive, punitive, or sarcastic remarks about my experience of driving while under the influence of alcohol. There were about 100 dippers there although I most likely only talked to between 30-40. Naturaly I had a great time with those from the Chicago-Madison area. The Luedi-Linsey beer bash was a bust, we arrived about midnight to find Luedi, Linsey, Williams, & Hamlin alseep (in seperate beds, please dont take it any other way) and no beer left in the room. Come to think of it there were no empty cans, anyone ready to start a lawsuit for false advertising.

Other things worthwhile, lets see: stealing Eric Kanes squirtgun and watching him run all over trying to avoid what he had given others. Watching Kathy Byrne wake up and try to violate Paul Rauterburg. Listening to Byrne and Becker admit they actualy like each other, both were completly plastered at this point in time.
