Time for our literary review (a new addition, everyone applaud and go ohhhh and ahhh)

Yes people I have decided to branch out and review a book or two in order to help you people decide to pick up something interesting as well as informative, and most importantly in this case, informative. Actualy I just finished this book and I just really liked it since it basicly agrees with most of the past philosophies that I have preached here.

Anyway the name of this particular book is The Virtue of Selfishness written by Ayn Rand sometime in the early 60's. Apparently it is an assortment of short articals written by Rand as well as four articals written by someone named Nathanial Brandon. (If anyone out there has ever heard about Brandon I would appreciate you letting me know what you can.) For anyone farmiliar with Rand this book is more or less an essay stating and explaining the lessons that she trys to give, actually she succeeds rather well, in her two great books the Fountainhead & Atlas Shrugged. Basicly both of these try to prove this one philosophy, I swear by my life and my love of it that I will never live for the sake of another man, nor ask another man to live for mine. For those interested that is the oath one had to swear to get into Galt's Gulch in Atlas Shrugged. (By the way I would recommend both Atlas Shrugged and the Fountainhead to anyone looking for a good book to read, for those of you valueing Steve Langley's opinion he is the one that got me to read the Fountainhead and he also liked Atlas Shrugged.)

In most of the short articals by Rand, 14 in all, she does her best to show that it is the individualist that realizes that it is up to him to make his own life. The most important part of her theory is that man must be a rational creature in order to survive as well as to advance. First she points out how plant life simply exists on a basic biological level simply maintaining it's existance with the minerals in it's immediate area. Secondly animals simply move on a very limited life cycle doing only what is needed for their basic existance. It is man however that can look beyond simple survival to actualy build for the future. Man's basic ability to do just this comes from his ability to think, to use the materials around him in order to build and increase his standard of living. Rationality is the key to man's ability to think, rationality is defined as the ability to serch out and to accept reality as it stands, not to put it aside because it does not fit in with that which we want. As an example it is basic reality that shows us that man must have air to survive and if he is to continue to survive he cannot forgoe that basic reality.

The main values in life according to Rand are reason, purpose, and self esteem with their corresponding virtues of rationality, productiveness and self esteem. The values of reason, purpose, and self respect are in essence three of the main ingrediants in that which is known as selfishness. As a result selfishness must also be a somewhat virtuess trait. Unfortunately selfishness has gottn an unearned as well as an undeserved bad reputation. Man by the very nature of his existance must seek to make his life better and more full, this means that he must work to improve himself as well as his lot, which is in essence selfishness. Nowadays however we constantly here selfishness being referred to in a very negative sence. There is something wrong with people who work for their own good, we are constantly told that we must devote ourselves to the good of society. In religion we here it is easier for a cammel to pass through the eye of a pin then it is for a rich man to enter heavan. In the papers we constantly read about how selfish succesfull men worry only about themselves despite the suffering masses. Even on the radio last night I heard a woman state that nobody can be truly fullfilled unless he devotes his life to others. All of these in essence say that selfishness is evil, yet none give any reason. They are all statements, none is a reason.

Basicly when you examine the altrustic theory of living your life for the good of others is a flawed theory at best. According to this theory every man holds a blank check upon us while we are allowed nothing on our own behalf. As a result our existance is for nothing but to be the servant of others as the only way we are allowed anything is to beg it from others upon whom we also hold a blank check. The altruists would do nothing but turn all of us into common beggers and how can any begger have any self esteem or respect. By the same token to do anything for one's self is known as wrong, though nobody has told us why, and as a result a man can never do something for himself but is to be reduced to both the mindless slave of everyone else as well as a begger to live off the charity of others rather then a man who is allowed to develop and grow on his own into an intelligent being that can hold self-respect and pride not only in himself but also in his work.

Actually Rand also spends a good deal of time in this book defending capatalism as the only system logically proper for man to adopt. Since capatalism is the only system on earth that truly allows each man to reach his potential, should he wish to do so, it is also the only rationally acceptable form of government for man. Socialism and Communism are in essence systems that claim man as a slave or property of society rather then guaranteeing man the rights of freedom that all hold so dear. Rand also defines the sole purpose of government as being that of protecting man's rights.

Rand defines man's rights as basicly freedom and assorted variations and developments of freedom. Man must be free to aspire and to create a better life for himself free from the worries of agression or physical force. This is where government comes in, it's only two purposes according to Rand are to protect the freedom of a man as well as to set up an equitable system of settling assorted contractual disputes. According to Rand man's main right in life is to be free to think, to create, to provide for his own, in essence to work and think to better his life. A man's right to life and happiness do not guarantee him a free ride of having food put in front of him, they do not guarantee him the right to a job, or the right to a car or shelter; his rights guarantee him nothing more then the chance to work and try to attain these things on his own. To allow him the right of a free meal, a roof over his head, etc. is to state that he has a right to leech. It follows from this that one of man's most important rights is his property right. Property is a result of a man's own work or ingenuity and as a result he should have a right to acquire it and dispose of it as he wishes without having any worries about claims from society, his neighbor, or the public at large.

Rand also goes on to attack the philosophy of Democracy to some degree as stating that it is the system of looters and thieves. In reducing the idea of democracy to it's basic level it is to some degree a justification of theft. As in the case of the United States and our policy of majority rule, to some degree it is a justification of looting and leachhood every time a program is enacted, espescially one in the name of the social or the humanitarian interests. As a very simple idea Democracy allows the majority to get together to legaly deprive it's most successfull of their property in the name of the social good.

Rand also attacks the idea of compromise as far as government is concerned. Put bluntly she states that there can be no compromise between right and wrong, for if they do indeed meat half way (the nature of compromise as we know it in politics today) then wrong has won in that it has gained something that it should not have and right has lost simply because it has given up something. The perfect example she points out here is one of trying to arrive at a compromise between a thief and his victim, the theif is due nothing and anything he gets is a victory for the thief and a loss for the victim, the fact that a thief may take less then originally intended is not the issue, it is simply that he has taken anything at all that makes it a loss. Put into practical terms every time there is a compromise in our governmental system with somebody gaining something in the name of the social good, this will always be done at the cost of the property or freedom rights of an individual which can only be wrong and a loss for that which is morally correct.

Another thing Rand attacks rather viciously is the idea of self sacrifice that we see preache today. Basicly the idea of sacrifice is to give up something of value for something of lessor value or of no value at all. The idea of working to attain something and then parting with it for something of less then equal value is against all basic as well as advanced concepts of rationality, yet this is considered a virtue by the liberals and altruists that infest our society today. Rand also points out that our asylums are full of people who are kept there precisly for being unable to establish value or having a perverted sence of value and as a result being unable to handle life in a rational manner. When you think about it put bluntly we encourage people to act in a way that we consider so abnormal that we lock people up for doing it.

While I found this book a little boring to some degree I am happy that I took the time to read it simply because of the explanations put forth in it as well as the basic premise of I swear by my life and my love of it that I will never live for the sake of another man, nor ask another man to live for mine. When you think about it, yes it is selfish but it is also one of the most rational thoughts a man could have and without rationality we would be no better off then the animals around us. Putting aside my inability as far as book reviews are concerned I would suggest you read the Virtue of Selfishness, it is well worth the time.
