If Fra Rem Any other than Bre And Rus rem A Mos or F Bla (#3) Notice that none of these cover Rus rem A Ser and Fra A Bre . This is a good lesson for all of you. Always send a set that covers ALL OTHER CASES! And Cliff, I tried to call you once, but I could not get You. Also, you could have made some units conditional on the French removal and some units on the Russian removal. It was your AND that made the orders invalid as none of them matched BOTH removals.
