I'd like to make some comments on Why Me #34. First, congrats on the Phillies fantastic winning of the World Series. I am also a baseball fanatic, since my Mets couldn't do it-I rooted the Phillies to victory. Good show !!

You brought up a subject that I think a lot of players can relate to; folding 'zines and orphan games. I'll tell you the truth-none of my games have ever been orphaned but I can see one of my Gm's on the brink of folding. Amazing as it seems, the players in this game all feel this will occur and we are already discussing GM's we will ask to take this gameimmediately. We don't want to be in limbo for six months.

A year or so ago Jerry Jones was ready to fold-but every game carried in LDNS would be completed. Jerry recently got a second wind & opened up a game. It filled very fast-why? Because when I joined his game I knew even if he wanted to fold his 'zine he would finish his games. This is the kind of GM this hobby needs. Guys who plunge head first in a shallow river and later find themselves stuck up to thier neck in mud are not for this hobby. Once a game is in full swing no one want s to see it go into limbo for six months or a year.

I would just like to state my appreciation to the GM's who are the backbone of this hobby, people like you, Jones, Michalski, Heinowski, & many more who make our games fun & make sure that they are not or-

((Thanks for your comments Kathy. You are very lucky to never have had a game orphaned. I've had several that were not only orphaned, but actually abandoned because the players had lost interest and the games couldn't be restarted. They are strictly forbidden under all circumstances. Regular pistols are allowed with a permit, but I understand it's very hard to get a permit. Fortunately there are consciencetious GM's in the hobby, and they don't get recognized to publicized as much because we tend to take them for granted.))


