Contreversy rears it's ugly head again....sigh.....
One of the games in Why Me (1980 AN) has started a feud in the hobby.
It distresses me very much that this has happened as I have always tried my best to avoid contreversy. For those of you who are unaware of this situation here's a brief rundown.

1) Jack Masters, in his 'zine <u>Black Frog</u> made the following remark.
" This was supposed to be a no holds barred game. What it actually was was a <u>set-up</u> for a Steve McLendon/Bob Sergeant alliance game". (the underlining is mine)

2) Steve McLendon, in his 'zine, wrote an editorial asking masters for an apology. They have also apparently exchanged letters about this.

3) Now, Jack Masters has written me and is very angry with me about the situation. He has resigned from the game for one, and has told me he wants nothing to do with me. He has also written me a very long letter that he asked me to publish in Why Me. My comments follow.

Jack, I never said anything hostile to you about this game. The only letter I wrote you was asking you to clear up what you meant by your "set-up" remark. You clarified this to me in your reply. If I was the least bit angry it was because you didn't print a clarification in Black Frog. I never said a thing about this situation in Why Me so Why should I print your letter in here? McLendon is the one you should be writing to, not me. I will print your brief statement here.

Statement from Jack Masters; My citation of 80AN in Black Frog was not intended to incriminate anybody in regards to the game, but merely to indicate the game for what it has been--MY LEAST FAVORITE GAME.

OK Jack, I've printed your statement. However, I must make one thing clear to you. I cannot, and will not allow Glenn Ledder to send orders for your country in this game. That would be the same as him playing two countries. It is my hope that you will continue to send orders for the game yourself. You are certainly welcome to do so. I have no reason to kick you out of the game. I also hope that this whole thing will stop escalating into a major feud.

Also: Glenn Ledder has written me a letter. I will not publish yours either Glenn as I refuse to get involved in escalating this whole affair. I DO appreciate the fact that you felt that I was "neutral and fair".

Finally; I hated to even have to say anything about this in Why Me. I felt compeled to do so because of all of the mention of it that is going on elsewhere. I only hope that it's settled soon.

Usually a simple failure to underline is not cause to delay a game, but in this case I feel I must as cooper made conditional orders and all of them contained orders for his non-existant F Bul. Endgame statement for 1979HD--Russia (Mike Conner)

I enetred 79HD as a standby in winter '02. Initial correspondance with England & Turkey seemed friendly, but Howe decided to persue a Scandinavian campaign. Fritter soon decided to turn against me as well, at the same time developing his position in the I/T alliance. When both Italy and Turkey dropped out, the game turned into a coalalititon of the replacement players Byrne, Kador, and Conner vs. the only surviving origional players: Schleinkofer and Howe. A 5 way draw seemed likely untill Kador's combination of NWRing and stabbibg his italiar ally gave the game to the western alliance. Despite a German invasion of Russian territory in spring '03, I managed to survive in my native Sevastapol at game's end. I consider my diplomacy to have been a failure, since I was unable to split up the two established allinces. The two most significant elements of the game were the determined, dedicated cooperation of the western allies, and the dropouts in the east. Each change of government gave the origional players a little more of an advantage. Congratulations to Art and Gary for a good demonstration of successful alliance play. Rasberries to Kador for blowing our chances for a share in the draw.
