## Sidney Bradshaw Fay

Proffesor Sidney B. Fay died last weekaat 91. His book, The Origins of the World War, and lectures delivered at Harvard in 1950-51 were important in leading me to the development of the game, Diphomacy. Prof. Fay paid unusual attention to the rule of the individual decision maker and his contacts with his counterparts in the diplomatic world. The whole interlock of meshing and conflicting intentions, accidents, blunders, etc., was carefully explored. His work appeared from the retrospect of 1951 as something of an antidote to more nearly deterministic approaches that had become prominent later.

The deadline for TURN 0 in the XENO game is September 25, 1967, however, since you cannot build ships on Turn 0 anyway, and since late players will be allowed to build ships at the same time they locate their planets (but only on their first Turn in the game), players who miss Turn 0 entirely will still get to build ships on Turn 1. (The deadline for Turn 1 will probably be October 10 or thereabouts.) We have a couple of nice press rabeases now for XENO #3. It will be out in a week. XENO #4 will appear before or after Turn 0, depending on how many presss releases will be available.
