(Berlin) Throughout the German Empire, Bells are ringing, as the last elements of Russian troops were driven from German territory. With this action, the new Government has fulfilled its pledges made over five years ago (real time). It can ably be called the beginning of a new era for Germany.

You will recall that, five years ago, Germany had no allies, a non aggression pact had been offered to Russia, Italian troops held much of the German Empire, we were constantly "hounded" in the skies, and the German Empire hardly extended beyond the borders of the Napoleonic Confederation of the Rhine.

With the capture of the Russian army in Silesia, the Government has regained all of Germany's historical territories. A firm alliance with France is a permanent feature of the new Europe.
