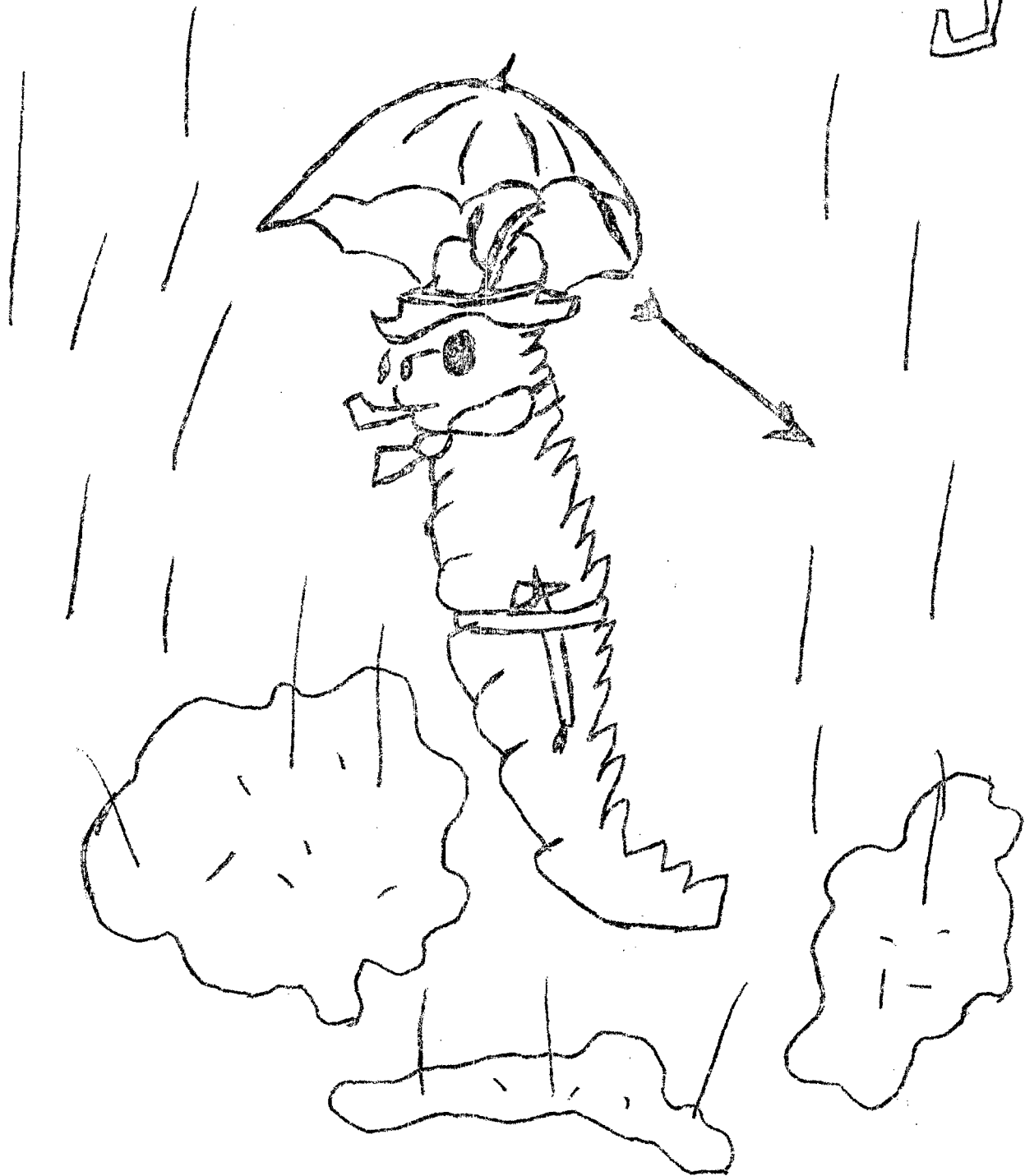


Wild n Woolly
