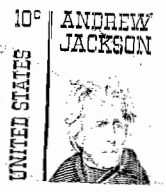
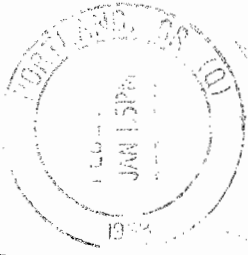
He should be greatly lauded, John Koning! and you should apologize.

Special Rule for Miskatonic University; Instead of moving or holding or supporting, a unit may be ordered to "Go Underground" and on subsequent turns may move about the board invisibly within the usual limitations except that it may occupy an area occupied by another unit. "Underground" units are invisible and have no effect on the game at all until they are ordered to "Reappear". Then they are, in effect, attacking the province they are in from off the board. If such an attack is unsuccessful, the unit is annihilated.

The above rule allows players to send their units behind enemy lines thus breaking deadlocked positions such as we have in 1965KM

Special Rule for Armageddonia; It now requires two moves to get from one province to another. You have move to the border between the provinces on one move and then to the province itself next move. In some places it is possible to be on a border of three provinces at once.
