Dropping the Challenge game is no great loss, I suppose. It would have been interesting to try my "rotating" players idea where the alternate players send in moves for all countries every turn. This would ensure orders for all the units on the board every turn as well as make possible more alliance shifts than we normally have.

The 1965KM game will go on as usual.; tho the underground army idea might have been fun. It works like this:

Turkey.; A-H might write orders like

Suppose A-H has been invaded by
Army Trieste Supports Vienna
Army Vienna Supports Trieste
Army Galicia goes underground

On subsequent moves the underground army moves about as usual except that it may enter provinces occupied by other armies and the location of this underground army is kept secret by the Gamesmaster; until A-H gives an order like; Army Serbia Re-appears

Now, the underground army is, in effect, attacking Serbia from off the board. If its unsuccessful, it is annihilated. While underground, such armies cannot give Support or affect other units or gain control of supply centers/

Fortunately, my wife has learned how to Gamesmaster. She will be doing most of the work in Wild 'n Wooly, KALMAR, and XENO and we thereby hope to catch up and keep more or less on schedule this year.

Next year

One of our big hangups is the machine we borrow to publish on. It has to be hand fed. Each sheet of paper must be laid evenly just touching the pressure roller with the left hand - then you turn the crank with the right hand and slip-sheet with your feet. Its a 1906 Rotary Neostyle and would do beautiful work if anyone made ink pads to fit it. But, unfortunately no one does, and the one we're using must be 20 years old. (this typer isn't much good either but half of it belongs to Swenson)

I'm hoping to make a trip to Seattle soon and try publishing an issue of KALMAR on their machine.
