(Paris) The French General Staff has decided to end the war against the Turks; this week's president agrees with the decision. The strategy is simple: from France's position in the South after 1909, the Turks and Russians cannot advance against a defensive posture of the French navy. This means the end of Turkish growth except at the expense of the Russians. Furthermore, since the Turks pose no threat to France, the French have offered the Turks a Treaty of Alliance, if they will only attack Russia. "With three enemies in the field," Marshall Debris said, "Russia will crumble. Because of the position of the Russian armies, the Turks are sure to pick up more of the territory than either the French or the English." a reply is expected from the Turks.

Rules for "Give-Away Diplomacy"

1. Players are chosen for each of the seven powers, England, France, Germany, Italy, Austria, Russia, and Turkey.
2. Each player starts the game with 11 units which the Gamesmasters scatter at random about the board, including Switzerland, Caspian Sea.
3. All units starting in land-locked areas become Armies and all units starting in sea areas become Fleets. The others are designated as Armies or Fleets at the choice of the player except that a minimum of 6 Armies are required for each player where possible.
4. Units are removed from the Board only when they are dislodged with no place to retreat to. Units are never removed for lack of supply centers.
5. Players are not required to build units but they may do so in their home supply centers that are under their control and vacant.
6. All retreats will be made by the Gamesmasters and will be to the available adjacent province that is "furthest" or "opposite" the source of the attacking unit.
7. The game will end in 1910 or as soon thereafter as one player has a clear minority of supply centers.
