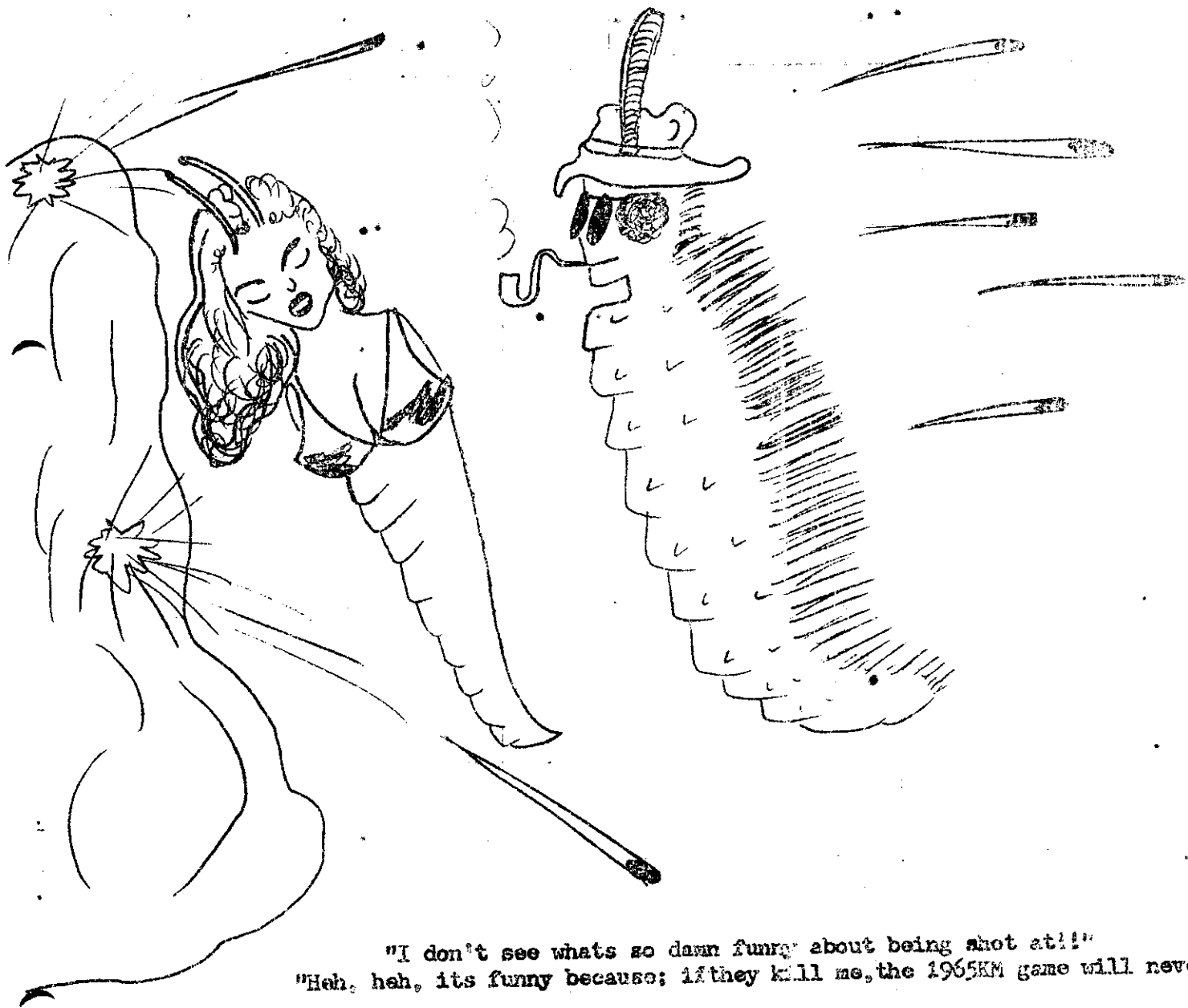

## TURN GAMESMASTERING

is a pretty simple idea. Several gamesmasters decide they like a great big game (like Das Dippyspiel in the Oz Free Press, for example). Then they agree to share the game fees and share the publishing and such. As soon as they have agreed upon the order in which they will take their turns; the first gamesmaster makes the announcement that they're going to publish the game. Then the second gamesmaster announces and publishes the rules. The third gamesmaster publishes the game list. The fourth gamesmaster publishes the first deadline and the revised rules. The fifth gamesmaster publishes the Spring 1901 moves. The sixth gamesmaster publishes the Retreats or the Fall moves or whatever is next and so on. (Incidentally, I am volunteering for such a rondelay, but I would like to get out of it if there are enough other volunteers.)

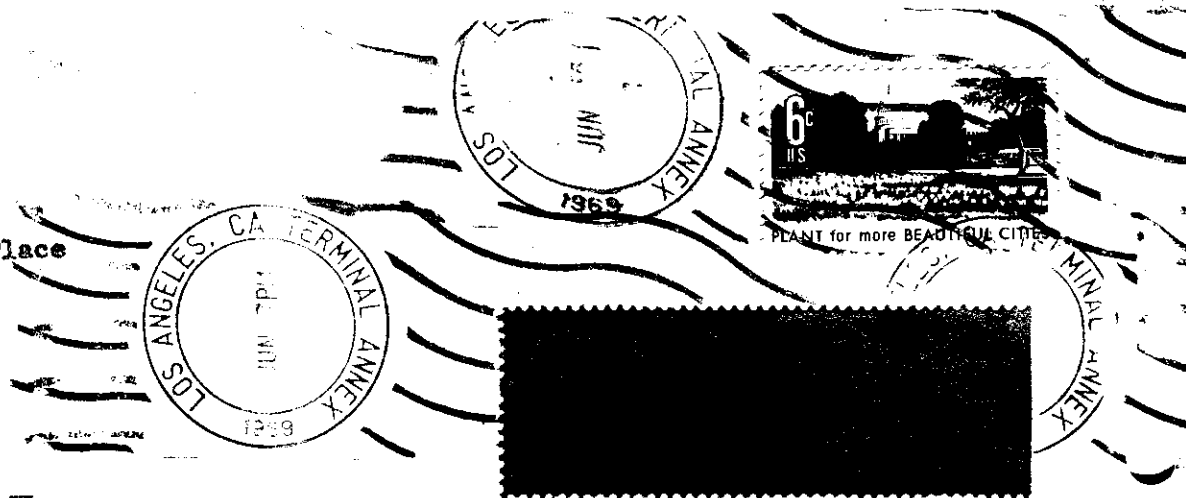
