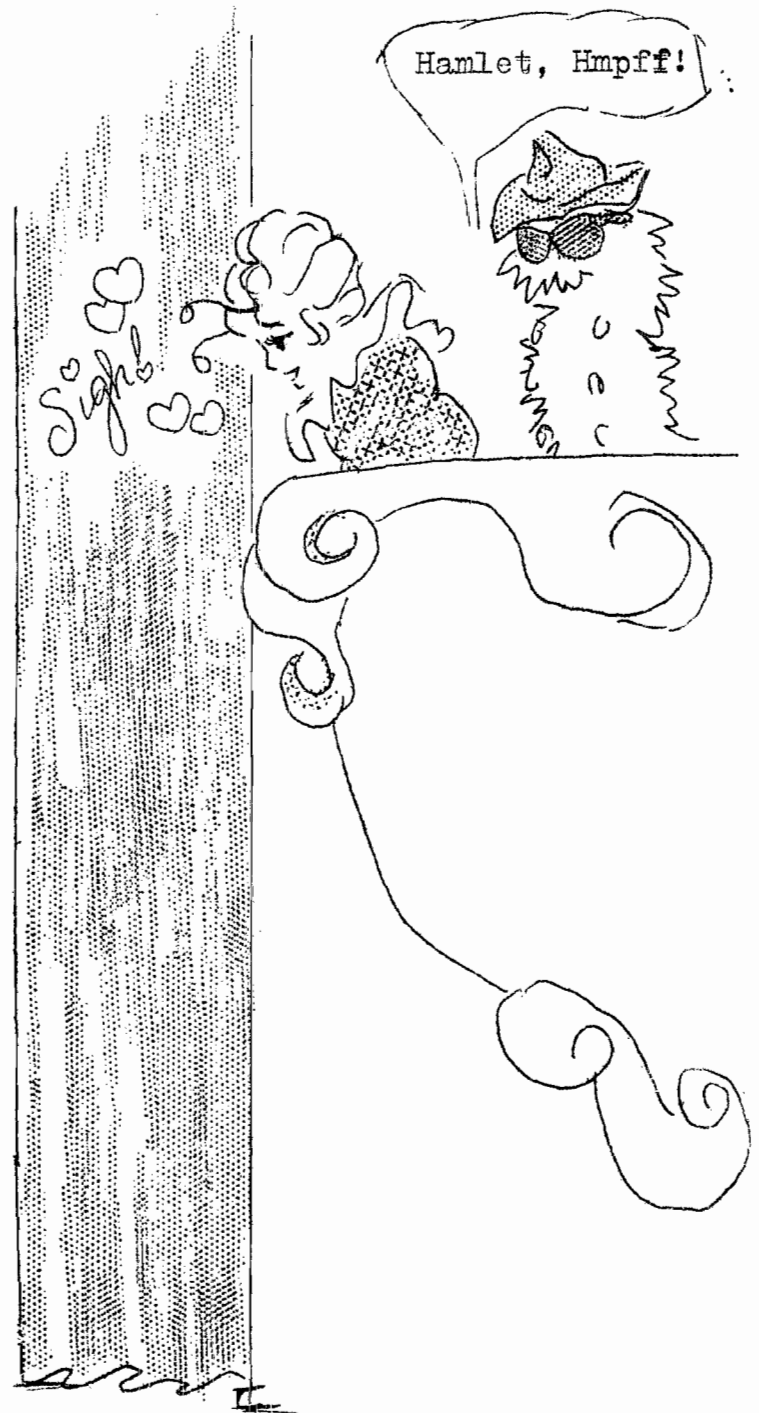
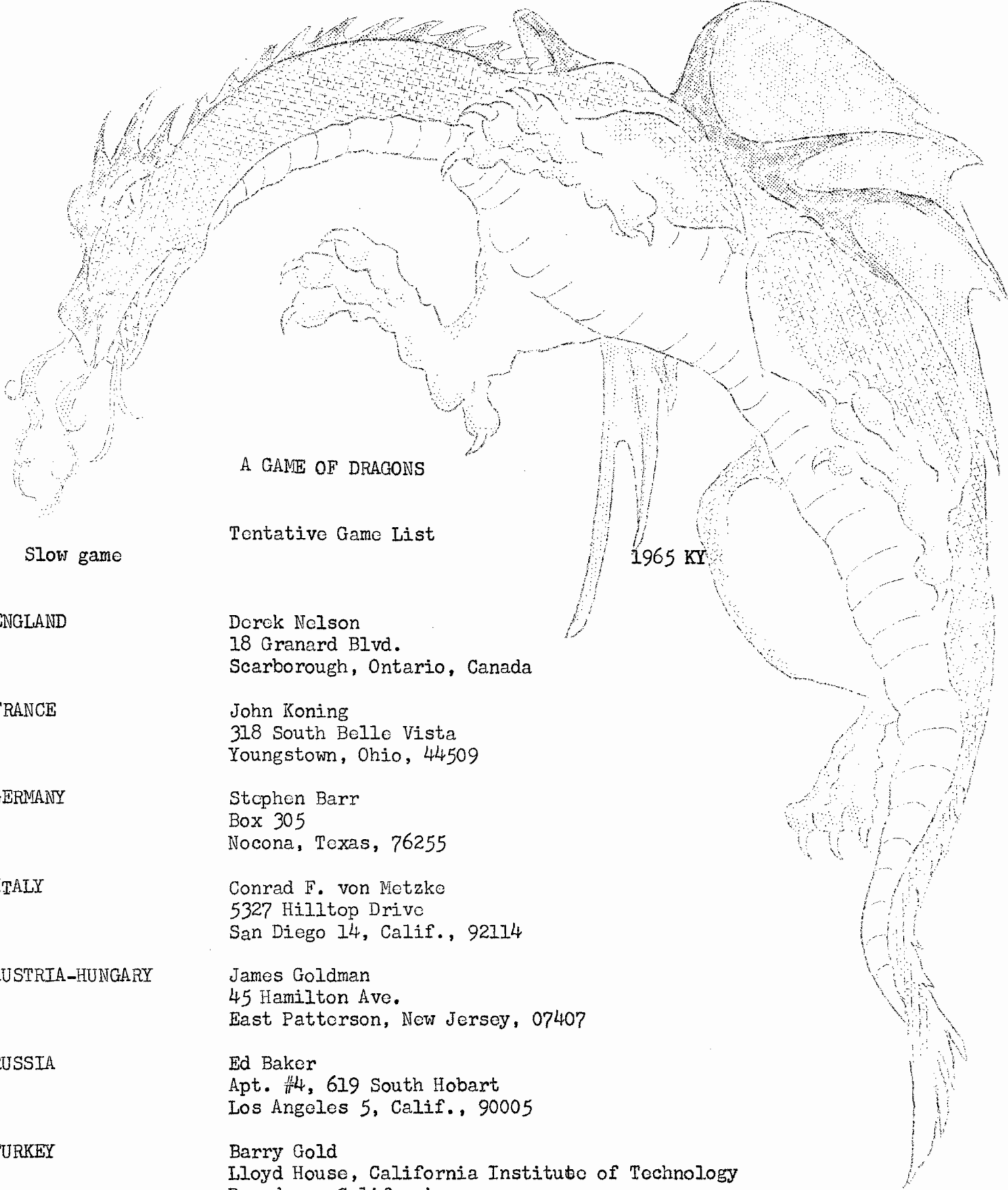

FRENCH MINISTER SENTENCED TO DEATH!

(Paris) Today, the Minister of the Interior was charged with high treason to France for giving the Defense Plans for the Winter Campaign to Germany. (Salzburg) (With the Emperor Johannes Wolfgangus I at the Music Festival)

We left the royal vaults at 6 am yesterday and have just arrived in this European Capital of Music. The Salzburg Opera is to give "Clemenza di Tito" tonight as a special tribute to the royal visit; von Euelow has come all the way from Frankfurt to conduct, and is sorry already.

The Emperor announced the creation of a 2nd Fleet in the coming weeks, to deal with the rising tension in the Cocos and Keeling Islands. May a whole fleet is needed, when one sailing brig did the job for the British, remains unexplained. To enter games, your choice of plan A or plan B;

Plan A Until May 30, 1965, \$3.00 (after May 30, 1965, \$4.00) for your first game and \$1.00 for each additional game. All games must be paid for on or before the Spring 1901 move of the first game that you enter and do not withdraw from on or before the Fall 1901 retreats.

Plan A WITHDRAWAL PRIVILEGE: You may withdraw from any game paid for under plan A and be entered into a new game at no charge provided that the Gamesmaster receives your written notice of withdrawal on or before the Fall 1901 retreats.

ANY DOLLAR PAID FOR A SUBSCRIPTION CAN BE CREDITED TO GAME FEES PAID WITHIN 30 DAYS.

You may have your named placed on the priority lists without paying any game fees. Game fees do not become due until the game starts except for \$1.00 "additional games" under plan A. State your choice of country and game speed.

When a game list is published, each player will have two weeks to withdraw from that game list without losing his priority to play that country at that game-speed. The first time that a game list is published, it will be called a "Tentative Game List". Two issues later, it will be published again and called a "Final Game List". The game will start in the following issue except for the slow games which will start in the second issue following.

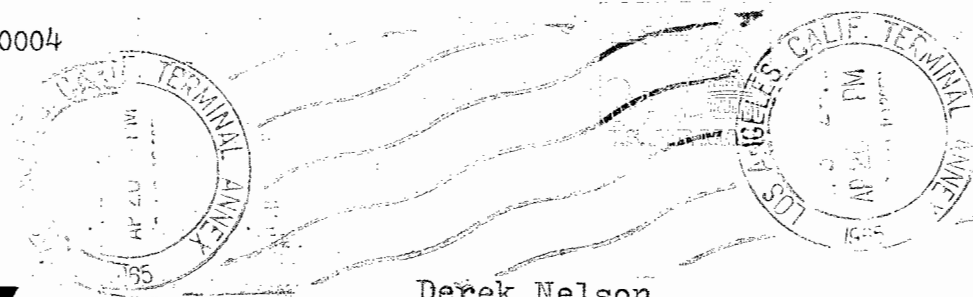
