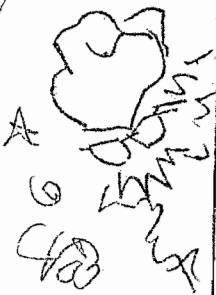

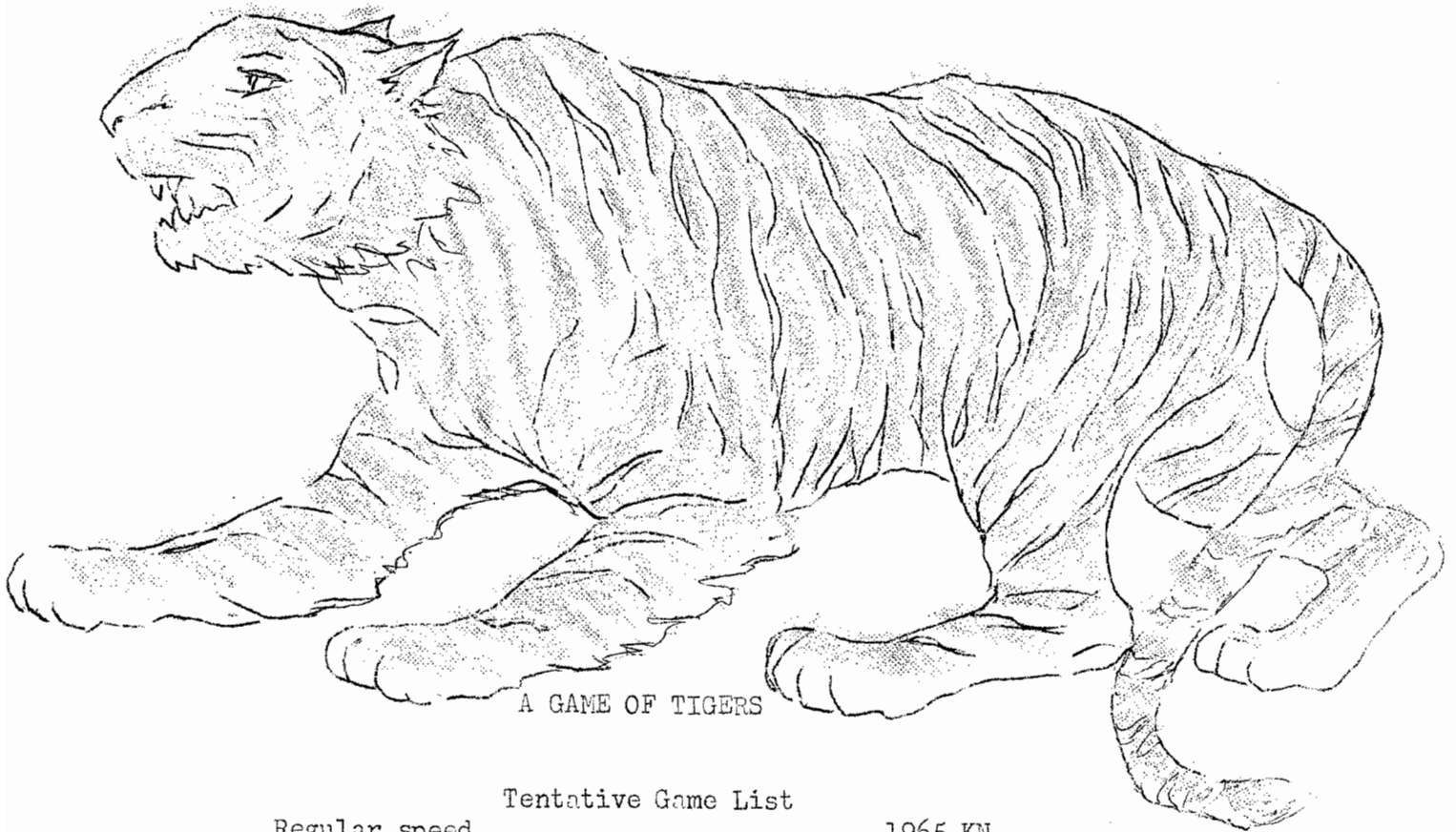

ITALY DELIVERS ULTIMATUMS!

(Trieste) In a joint announcement today Austrian and Italian officials made public the formation of the Mediterranean League, designed to keep the peace in the Balkans and Central Mediterranean. Midst the popping of champagne corks, it was disclosed that Austrian and Italian forces have already fought their first joint battle, defeating a mysterious cavalry force raiding Western Thrace. It was also revealed that Italian troops have occupied Salonika, as an administrative base.

(Rome) The Government of Italy demands that the Government of Turkey cease its vile attacks on Austria and Greece. Further such assaults will be viewed as a most serious provocation by the Government of Italy.

The Government of Italy demands that the Government of Russia will direct its forces to retire from their illegal position in Galicia. Be it known by adventurist monarchs that attacks on Austria will be considered a declaration of war on Italy.

The Government of Italy begs to inform the government of France of Italian desires for a Franco-Italian Pact of Non-Aggression, with the intent of leaving mutual boundaries of these two great nations free of military occupation.

RUSSIAN ARMY GALICIA RETREATS TO BOHEMIA

BLITZKRIEG is a super-fast game played by Diplomacy rules with the following innovations:

1. Spring and Fall moves must be submitted together.
2. Retreats and Build orders must be submitted along with the moves at the same time.
3. The Gamesmaster will not make any retreats or builds for any player even though there is no choice involved.
4. Units dislodged and not given a retreat order or given a retreat order to an occupied area or the area where a stand-off occurred, will be removed from the play.

THE TRUSTING SOULS

(Berlin) The German Republic has ordered all units to assume defensive positions to allow the English Government an opportunity to complete the truce they have called for. We will honor this agreement, but if France does not take the required steps immediately, we will call upon the English Government to honor their commitment of #17 AND SUCH ADDITIONAL ALLIES AS WE MAY FIND WILLING TO AID A RIGHTEOUS CAUSE.

Dr. Hans Mussenger has been named as Ambassador to France. Dr. Mussenger, formerly Ambassador to Turkey, will assume his new duties immediately. The Ambassador to Austria-Hungary has been recalled for diplomatic consultation and will assume Dr. Mussengers place in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. No new Ambassador to Austria or to the Turkish Government in Exile has been named.

(Warsaw) In an unexpected surprise move, President (and National Father figure) Andrzej Sawiczewski fired his two top military advisors and replaced them with civilians.

Uncerimoniously given the axe, were Naval Chief of Staff Admiral Mikhail Trudnikov and Army Chief General Maximillian Schneetrager. In their steads, Sawiczewski announced the appointments of Dr. Roberts Q. Maknamarakov to replace Admiral Trudnikov, and Professor Etaion Shrdlu to replace General Schneetrager. Both men are close friends of Finance Minister Dr. Eto Karandash, who is reportedly the most influential person in the Polish cabinet.

Sawiczewski also announced that if the Polish Capitol is ever conquered, a government will be re-established in the, as yet undiscovered, Antartic Territory. From there, announced the glorious president, a cold war can be fought against the bad guys.

(Vienna)

Rumour has it that the Ambassador from Germany has been murdered by secret police. A government statement, the only comment received from any government sources, is that the Ambassador has returned to Germany. A military gaurd is holding the German Embassy closed to all.

Military sources yesterday denied that any aggressive action was in the making against Poland. The military is quiet on all subjects today. It is believed that peace still exists between Poland and Austria-Hungary. We certainly hope so. Austro-Hungarian resources will be badly drained enough with the defending of large areas of Greece from the attempted invasions from Italy.

Plan A WITHDRAWAL PRIVILEGE: You may withdraw from any game paid for under plan A and be entered into a new game at no charge provided that the Gamesmaster receives your written notice of withdrawal on or before the Fall 1901 retreats.

You may have your name placed on the priority lists without paying any game fees. Game fees do not become due until the game starts except for \$1.00 "additional games" under plan A. State your choice of country and game speed.

When a game list is published, each player will have two weeks to withdraw from that game list without losing his priority to play that country at that game-speed. The first time that a game list is published, it will be called a "Tentative Game List". Two issues later, it will be published again and called a "Final Game List". The game will start in the following issue except for the slow games which will start in the second issue following.

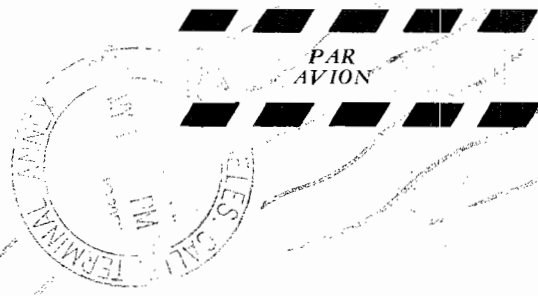
