



(Vienna) At the request of the Italian government, the Austrian armed forces have seized key points to prevent a rear line insurrection. These units will be withdrawn after peace and order is restored. The provinces of Venice, Rome, and Frans Tyrolia are under martial law as are the Military departments of the Po and the Tiber.

The 101st Medical Corps was today rushed from Trieste to Venice to help combat the plague. The hospital ship "Reknown" with escort is also on its way to Venice.

Roma (Nones of July, MCMVI AD) Emperor Claudius III today informed the Senate and People of Rome that pirates from Transalpine Gaul have raided the Ligurian coast. "Despite these raids, however," he told the people of the revived Roman Empire, "we have sublime confidence in the ultimate victory. In the parts of the Roman Empire to the East, which have been successfully recalled to their allegiance, fresh troops are being raised to throw back these invaders. I can authoritatively state that the III Legion will be raised in Venetia this winter, manned by thousands of enthusiastic volunteers from Achaia, Macedonia, and Thrace. The strength of the Roman fleet will also be further increased."

Constantinopolis (Day before the Ides of July, MCMVI AD) Caesers have arrived in this city before. But today, for the first time, a Roman Emperor came to the second city of the Empire by air: Claudius III landed today on a field just outside the city, in an experimental aircraft piloted by Col. Dedalo. The liberated people of Constantinopolis cheered wildly as he entered the newly recaptured city in a triumphal procession. For the first time in over IV and a half centuries, Constantinopolis, the ancient Byznatium, is a Roman and Christian city. Even the Turks, demoralized by the collapse of their armed forces, and the anarchy that has reigned in their country, went over to the Roman Empire. Many have volunteered for the III Legion.

The Emperor continues his reogganization of the Roman Empire. The newly acquired Turkish provinces of Istanbul and Izmir have been reconstituted as the Roman provinces of Thrace, Asia, Lycia, Pisidia, Pamphylia, Lycaonia, Cilicia, Cappadocia, Syria, Palaestina, and Arabia Felix.

Roma (Three days before the Kalends of September, MCMVI AD) Today, in a formal ceremony in St. Peter's Basilica, Pope Sylvester IV formally excommunicated President Jacques Racine of France, and absolved the people of France from their allegiance to his government. The Emperor is believed to support the Pope's action, though he is said to feel that a couple of extra fleets in the enemy rear would be more help.

"This Galic renegade," said the Pope, "forgets that, as a subject in the province of Gallia Inferior, he is bound to obey the dictates of the Emperor of Rome. Our Divinely Inspired Emperor is legitimate successor to not only the ancient Emperors of Rome and Byzantium, but also to the Holy Roman Emperors, and as such has euthority over all of Christendom."

Afterwards, a paple spokesman was asked how the universal authority of the Emperor could be reconciled with his alliance, on equal terms, with the Republic of Poland. "His Holiness believes," said Monsigner Xavier Rynne, "that the Emperor has authority over all Christendom. To judge from the way they've hben behaving themselves in Scandinavia, the Poles certainly can not be considered Christians."

Roma (Two days before the Nones of September, MCMVI AD) Emperor Claudius III today confirmed that the Roman Empire and the Republic of Poland have delineated spheres of influence in Eastern Europe, and are acting in concert against the Gauls. "Aside form insignificant border areas," said the Emperor, "no parts of the Polish sphere ever belonged to the Roman Empire. Therefore, the alliance is consistent withour task of restoring the glories of ancient Rome. After the last remnants of German, Pannonian, and Turkish troops have been interned, all forces of the Roman Empire and the Republic of Poland will be thrown into the struggle against the Gauls." This alliance has been given the name United Resistance of Romans and Poles.

Venetia (III ante Kalendas Ianuarii, MCMVI AD) Emperor Claudius III told the officers and men of the newly founded III Legion that they would have the honor of avenging the Roman Empire against the Gallic corsairs who are presently threatiening the western and southern coasts of Italia.

"Already our glories in the East have been revived," hetold a cheering audience of soldiers and civilians. "Dalmatia, Vindobona, Hellas, Constantinoplis, Syria, and Asia Minor again acknowledge the rule of Rome. As in centuries past, Rome gives law to the East. It now becomes our task to turn to the West. While our forces were elsewhere, Gallic pirates sacked our naval base at Carthage, and today pillage the costs of Etruria as their ancestors did XXV centuries ago. This insolence of revolted provincials shall not be borne. Together with our Sarmatian allies, who today challenge Gallic domination of Germania, we shall drive the Gaul into the uttermost West, and there divide him into three parts!"

Neapolis (Nones Januarii, MCMVIIAD) Last fall, it had been feared that the plans to build a V fleet in Neapolis would be thwarted by the activities of Gallic pirates in Mare Nostrum. But the inspired maneuvers of Admiral Marco Vissanio not only kept the French out of this port, but left it free for naval construction. By spring, a Vfleet will add its power to the IV Roman navies already challenging French domination of the middle sea.

Vindobona (XI ante Kalendas Februarii MCMVII AD) The Emperor visited this ancient frontier city for the first time since its reunion with the Roman Empire in last year's campaign. Despite the best efforts of the men of the II Legion, the city still showed signs of the disorder in which the previous government had left it.

"It is with particular pleasure that We visit Vindobona and see it garrisoned with Roman legionaires," the Emperor told a review of the Legion. "It was in this capital, then given the barbarious name of "Wien", that Kaiser Philip I of the late unlamented Bieber Dynasty swore allegiance to a pact of alliance between his Empire and the then Kingdom of Italy. It was also from their capital that his orders went out to betray that solemn alliance, and to retain Helas, rather than to turn it over to the Roman Empire. He has now met the rewards of his treachery. Although one Hungarian army is still immured in its fortresses on the Pannonian plain, the Austro-Hungarian Empire is ended. Our treaty with the Republic of Polan provides that the Pannonian plain shall fall to the Polish sphere of influence, and We have every hope that, during the forthcoming year of MCMVII, both the Austro-H ngarian and Turkish Empires will be removed from the face of Europe."

In the old days of the Roman Empire, this town was called "Vindebona". Thus was it also called in the barbarous Latin used in the official documents of the Holy Roman Empire when it was ruled from this capital. That name we now declare abolished: Henceforth, this city shall be called "Claudiana."



## Rules to be followed by the Gamesmaster

- 1. All of the original rules as published by Games Research, Inc. will be adhered to. (except for the choosing of countries by lot.)
- 2. A precedent set in a game will be followed throughout that game.
- 3. No conditional move will be accepted.
- 4. No joint moves will be accepted.
- 5. Any unit attempting to move may be Supported only to where it is going. If stood off, it cannot be Supported in the province it is in.
- 7. When a unit is successfully attacked from a province that it is attempting to move to, it still stands off any equally or less Supported unit that may be attempting to follow the succussful attacking unit.
- 8. No moves, retreats, of building of units will be done for any player by anyone other than that player. No retreats will be made automaticly or conditionally. Even though there may be no choice involved, a unit that is dislodged and not given a retreat order will be removed from the board.
- 9. Deadlines will not be postponed for any reason with the exception of the extra 5 or more days over Christmas.
- 10. When a player resigns, his units will hold or attempt to hold (and may be Supported for Holding by other players) for the remainder of the game. Replacement players will usually be required to pay a small fee and all of the other players in the game must agree (in writing) to the replacement before his moves can be used in the game.
- 11. The rule against two units exchanging places will be applied regardless of what fancy convoy maneuvres may be attempted to effect the exchange.
- 12. The decisions of the Gamesmaster, right or wrong, and of his Assistant, right or wrong, are final. (On the date of this writing the Assistant Gamesmaster is Earl Thompson)
- 13. A convoy move does not cut the Support against the fleet that is the last fleet to convoy the army in the "convoy-chain". When one of the fleets in the "convoy-chain" is dislodged, the attempted convoy does not cut any Support at all.
- 14. When two or more units are dislodged and ordered to retreat to the same place; they are both, or all, removed from the board,
