Be it known that players attempting to place their moves in our editorial office ON the postmark deadline are showing more concern than the game demands. The postmark deadlines are intended to place the moves in our hands sufficiently in advance of their publication. POSTMARK deadlines are not RECEIPT deadlines.

NEW GAMES

We expect to start one new game per month this year. To enter games, you have your choice of plans A or B:

- Plan A \$5.00 (Only \$4.00 until January 31, 1966) for the first game and \$1.00 for each additional game (many players are engaged in several concurrent games). The fees for additional games must be paid on or before the Fall 1901 move of the player's first game.
- Plan B No entrance fee but \$1,00 must be paid on or before the Spring move of each even-numbered game year until \$8.00 has been paid. This is \$1 per three months over the first two years of play. Here the player can discontinue paying when he discontinues playing.
