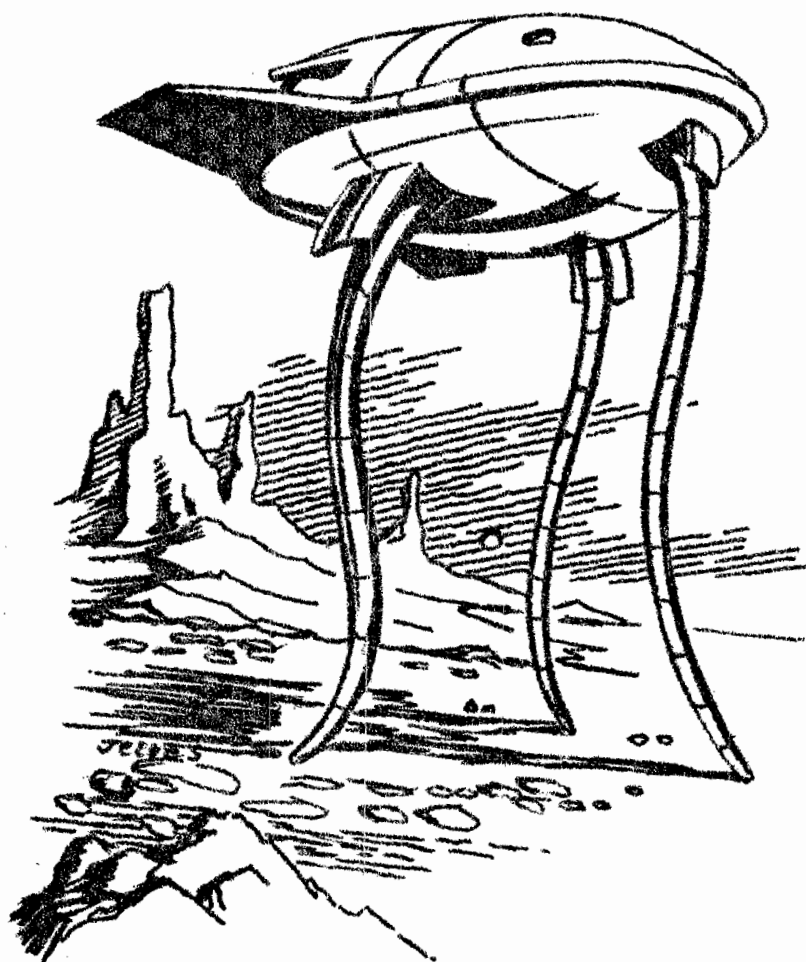


# WILD 'N WOOLY

(Paris) By an 8-7 vote the Franco-English Cabinet today instructed King John II to demand an apology for the recent Austrian attack on French forces in violation of treaty terms and to break diplomatic relations, if said apology is not soon forthcoming. It is also authorized, again by an 8-7 vote that the construction of a fleet at Brest to meet the Italian menace. The new fleet makes the combined navy of France and England strong again.

(Berlin) After five years of close co-operation, five years of friendship, (and good natured double dealing) five years during which the proud German soldiery have saved the Russians again and again from the rapacious Austrians, our friends, our allies have broken their promises one after another. Where was the fleet that was supposed to Support us into Edinburgh? Where was the aid we hoped for? And! More important, what is that Russian army doing in Prussia?? GERMANY DECLARES WAR ON RUSSIA! Why not? We're fighting every-one else, already.

(Rome) The Italian Government announced today that it intends to honor all treaties and agreements entered into with the Austro-Hungarian Empire. Concerning the presence of Italian forces within the Empire, Count Garlic-npeppers stated that the troops are there at the request of the Kaiser Franz Joseph and will be immediately withdrawn.

(Nice) The recent series of armed clashes in Burgundy between German and Italian troops continues to worry the Italian Chief of Staff. Are the Germans preparing to invade Southern France? Are the clashes between patrols going to escalate into major engagements involving entire armies? As a precaution, the General Staff has ordered the newly formed 6th Army to join the present occupation forces in France and Spain. Also, the 5th Army is being readied should they be needed.

The Game of the Dragons	Slow game	One game year per 10 issues
The Game of the Tigers	Regular speed	One game year per 5 issues
The Game of the Wolves	Fast Game	One game year per 2 issues (It is necessary to include your retreats and build orders with your moves and they may <u>not</u> be conditional!)
The Game of the Devils	Blitzkrieg	One Game year per issue (There is still a \$20 prize for the first Blitzkrieg player to take all 34 supply centers in a Blitzkrieg game but it seems very doubtful that we will ever get 7 players.)

You also have a choice of payment plans A or B:

Plan A \$5.00 for the first game and \$1.00 for each additional game paid for at the same time. Game fees must be paid on or before the publishing of the Final Game List. (The Final Game List is published two or more issues after the Tentative Game List. This will allow you 15 days to get your payment in when you see your name on a Tentative Game List.)

Plan B No entrance fee but \$1.00 must be paid on or before the Spring move of each even numbered Game Year until you resign.

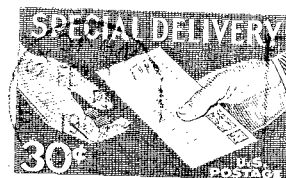
